ELIZABETH AVERSA is both a popular and familiar voice in support of Sarasota Opera through her informal lectures in the Prologues and Listen & Learn Series as well as for editing of the SOG newsletter and regular column for the Manatee Opera Guild newsletter.

Elizabeth completed her PhD at Drexel University. She enjoyed nearly 50 years in the field of library and information studies, working as state library consultant, communications director, professor, researcher, and dean. She now holds the title of professor emerita at The University of Alabama.

In Tuscaloosa, Elizabeth served as president of the Tuscaloosa Symphony Orchestra Guild and as president of the Osher Lifelong Learning Institute (OLLI) at the University of Alabama (UA). She was a founding member and later president of the Opera Guild of the UA Opera Theatre.

Among awards Elizabeth received are Educator of the Year from the American Library Association, Professional Service Alumni Award from Drexel University, Alabama Librarian of the Year, and Tuscaloosa Arts Council Music Volunteer of the Year and was most recently inducted into the Alabama Communications Hall of Fame.

In her spare time Elizabeth teaches online and bicycles to raise funds for cancer research.
