As forever students our skills are constantly evolving and this sheet gets updated as we grow. Everyone who volunteers for us has no less than 90 day onsite training as well as prior or living experience in relation to what we offer before being brought on. Our team comes from a diverse set of backgrounds from sex workers to generationally impoverished. Our diverse backgrounds shape exactly how effective our mission is.

Safety Staff

We are not security services but will work in tandem with your security to provide wrap around services.

- \$100 per person with a minimum two hired per event.(totalling \$200) Price for this is needs based
- Staff can be unmarked or marked via badge or tshirt for easy identification
- Staff communicates through the radio. Everyone in a group chat to report events.
- Incident reports to be turned in within 10 days after.
- Naloxone administration and rescue breathing if needed.
- Mediation when harm has been caused.
- Trauma informed care for patrons that find themselves targets of violence. We run our protocols for this. Hosts can review these prior to the event. We will relay the response to the promoter. **THIS IS NON NEGOTIABLE.**
- Bystander trained, to provide early intervention to disputes, fights, and consent violations, with the intention of creating a Healthy Community Space. This calls for us to work with the promoter to run our protocols to the proper channels.
- Metal detection wand and bag checks available. Protocols set by host in regards to items we can dismiss.

Standard Harm Reduction Table providing outreach only

Starting at \$200 for well funded events

- 6ft x 24in table or 4ft depending on event funding.
- Full inventory & educational materials displayed. 90% of which are free to your patrons. This includes a variety of items such as drink covers to prevent spiking, condoms, narcan, fentanyl test strips, ear plugs, emergency contraceptive, birth control, safer use supplies, drug checking kits from both grassrootsharmreduction.org and pagroundhogs.org as well as educational materials tailored to the theme of the event or community we are servicing.
- On the spot naloxone training for patrons.
- Basic First Aid and Sanctuary to those who need it.

Standard Harm Reduction Table With Safety Support Staff

This is our most commonly requested service.

This pricing provides full coverage community care.

Starting at \$250 for well funded groups.

- 6ft x 24in table.
- 2-3 Marked Staff via badge or shirts.
- Full inventory & educational materials displayed. 90% of which are free to your patrons. This includes a variety of Items such as drink covers to prevent spiking, condoms, narcan, fentanyl test strips, ear plugs, emergency contraceptive, birth control, safer use supplies, drug checking kits from both grassrootsharmreduction.org and pagroundhogs.org as well as educational materials from a variety of local and national organizations.
- On the spot naloxone and drug checking training for patrons.
- Bystander trained, to provide early intervention to disputes, fights, and consent violations, with the intention of creating a Healthy Community Space. This calls for us to work with the promoter to run our protocols to the proper channels.
- Trauma informed care for patrons that find themselves targets of violence. We run our protocols for this and will relay the response to the promoter.

THIS IS NON NEGOTIABLE.

- Safer Space protocol creation with the venue, promoter, and what enforcement of that looks like. What this means is creating a space with NO-isims and NO-phobias associated with a protected class of people. We prioritize protecting people.
- Advocacy and Mediation to increase preventive safety that meets the unique needs of the community.
- Basic First Aid, Narcan Administration, and Sanctuary to those who need it.
- Heat Stress mitigation tactics such as scanning the crowd for symptoms, Ice pack availability, and openly giving away free water when possible. We can provide up to two 5 gallon water/gatorade drink stations upon request.

Free Confirmatory Lab Testing

We are proud to announce that it is now available through our partnership with P.A.G. This is a new form of harm reduction in PA that offers free lab drug checking services in an effort to anticipate overdose spikes before they happen & warn people who use drugs of high potency, or adulterated supply. This ambitious new initiative seeks to bring transparency to Pennsylvania's illicit drug supply, anticipate the movement of tainted drugs, correct media disinformation, & improve healthcare outcomes for people who use drugs.
