




Sukoon on Hamzah

Hamzah is a letter like any other letter of the Arabic Alphabet. It can come at the start, in the middle or at the end of a word and can have any Vowel sign or Sukoon on it.

Hamzah can occur as a standalone letter or it may need a seat (کُرْسِی) either an Alif, Yaa, or Waow.

When there is a Sukoon on the letter Hamzah, the <u>sound of the vowel</u> on the preceding letter is cut.

Tanween



Tanween means "nunation" - the addition of an "n" or "i" sound at the end of a word. It is shown by doubling the three short vowel signs (Fathah, Kasrah, or Dhammah) to make the "an", "in" or "un" sound.

It is always found at the end of a word – not at the start or in the middle of the word.
