YOUR SURVEY RESULTS:

Successful & Sustainable VS. Oil Slimeball / Villain

NO. OF VEHICLES	POINTS			
Vehicle obtains LESS than 20 mpg of gasoline/diesel = GRADE F	-2 Points (minus)			
Vehicle obtains LESS than 35 mpg of gasoline/diesel= GRADE D	-1 Point (minus)			
Vehicle obtains 35 mpg or more of gasoline/diese = GRADE C	+1 Point			
Vehicle obtains 45 mpg or more of gasoline/diesel = GRADE B-	+2 Points			
Vehicle obtains 60 or more mpg of gasoline/diesel = GRADE B	+3 Points			
Vehicle obtains 75 mpg or more of gasoline/diesel = GRADE B+	+4 Points			
Drive plug-in hybrid vehicle = GRADE A-	+6 Points			
Use mass transit that relies on oil = GRADE A-	+6 Points			
Vehicle is all-electric or alternative fuel cell = GRADE A	+7 Points			
(If your electricity is primarily generated by coal, then your carbon footprint won't be as substantial. Local power plant must significantly decrease or eliminate coal consumption.)				
Use alternative fuel mass transit (trains, busses)/carpool for work = GRADE A+	+8 Points			
Walk; bicycle; skateboard/scooter to work/school= GRADE A+	+9 Points
