It is my great pleasure to introduce to you Pacific College of Technology (PCT), an award-winning college close to the heart of Sydney, Australia.

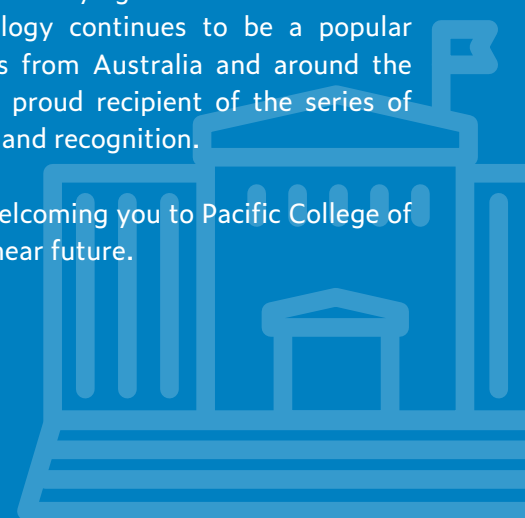
We are registered with the Australian Skills Quality Authority (ASQA) which is the national Vocational Education and Training (VET) regulator to deliver nationally recognised qualifications.

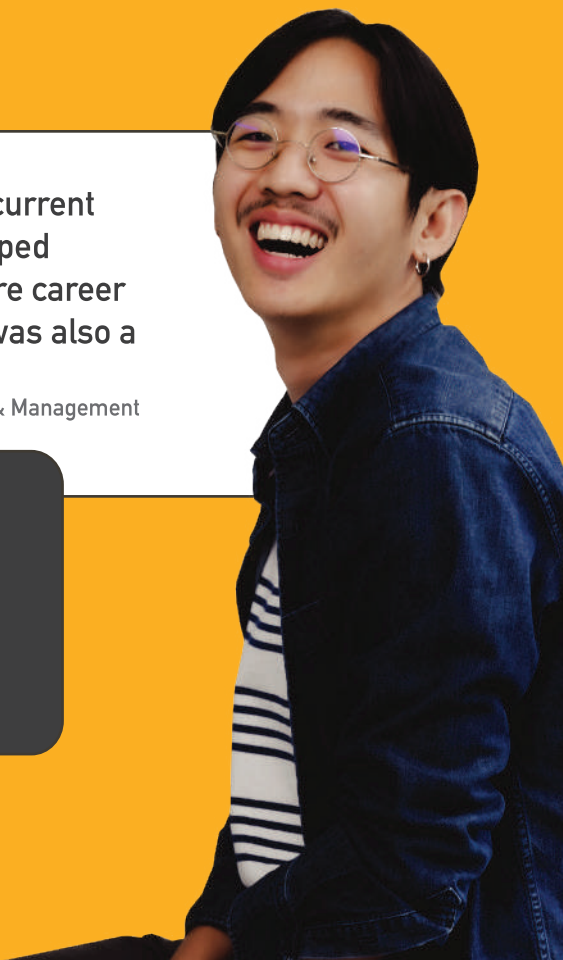

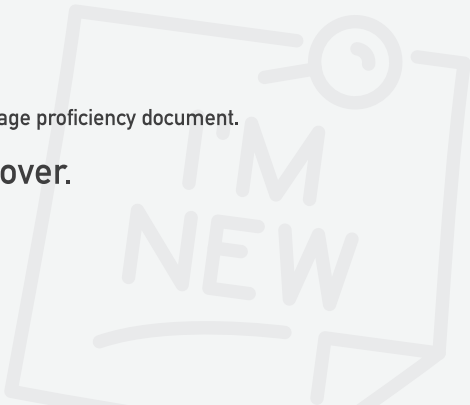

Requirements and Commitments for Enrolling in Practical Courses

Students seeking admission to Cert-III, Cert-IV, Diploma and Advanced Diploma courses must have completed schooling equivalent to Australian Year 12. Students seeking admission to Graduate Diploma courses must have completed an advanced diploma or bachelor's degree.

English Proficiency Requirements

Students seeking admission to Cert-III, Cert-IV, Diploma and Advanced Diploma courses must demonstrate an IELTS score of 6.0 each band, Or PTE score of 52 each band. Students seeking admission to Graduate Diploma courses must demonstrate an IELTS score of 6.0 each band, Or PTE score of 52 each band.

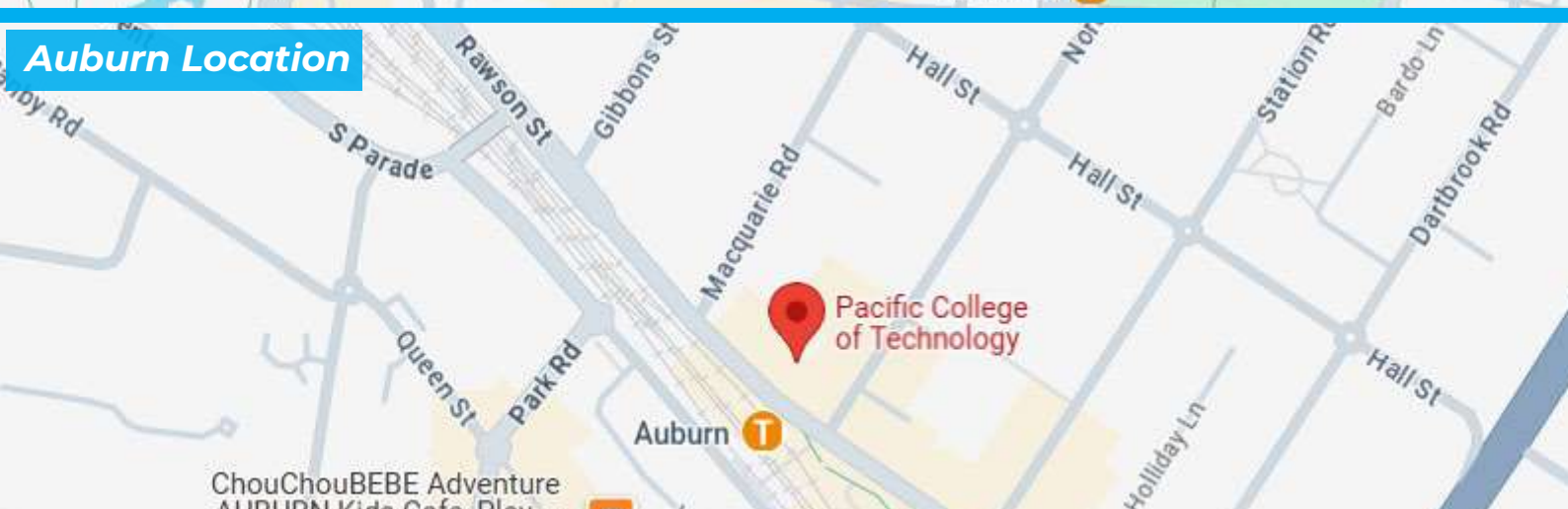
