- Targets are steel circle or rectangular plates.
- All courses of fire are timed events.



Practices & Competitions

Practices are typically Sunday mornings. These practices are at Pima Pistol Club in Oro Valley or Southeast Regional Park Shooting Range. We practice with .22 caliber pistols and rifles, 1911, and Optics. As we approach competitions, practices may occur more frequently. So always check the team calendar on our website.

The focus of practices will be on technique and procedures. Since teams are in groups of four, working with your teammates become crucial in preparation, technique, and support.



Joining

No experience is needed to join our team. Because this is a scouting team, every measure is taken to ensure the safety of our members and environment. Boy Scout and Scholastic Action Shooting program regulations are followed. The team has equipment. However, it is advised that you bring eye and ear protection and face mask.

Requirements: SASP registration is \$25; Uniform cost is approximately \$70; ammunition may be purchased through the team.

To compete, youth members must be a Venture Crew member.
