



Expenses

\$100 payable to Baden-Powell Scholastic Pistol Team.

This pays for the following expenses:

- \$20 Fee to the Scholastic Shooting Sports Foundation (insurance)
- \$50 Fee to join team
- \$20 One box of ammunition (325 rounds)
- \$10 Pays for products that the team consumes

It is necessary for SPP athletes to provide their own ammunition.

SPP athletes may purchase ammunition from the team **when it is available**. Otherwise, they can purchase ammunition from the Catalina Council.

Equipment

SPP athletes are expected to bring to every practice;

- Eye protection
- Ear protection
- Brimmed hat
- Appropriate clothing
- A minimum of 1 quart of water
- A 3-ring binder for your targets and time logs

SPP athletes may share in the use of the Team firearms.

SPP athletes may provide their own firearms that comply with IDPA SSP or SSR rules.

- Each firearm should have 5 magazines

Athletes affiliated with the team are eligible to purchase a firearm from one of our industry partners at a price that is substantially discounted from retail. Ask the Coach for more details. Otherwise, this information will be distributed when the opportunity arises.

Uniforms

Orders for team shirts and hats will be taken each year. Uniforms are **not** required for local practices.

- Shirts ~\$40
- B-ball caps ~\$15

Travel

Athletes will make their own travel arrangements for local practices and events out of town.

Fundraisers

Each athlete will be expected to participate equally in the annual Team Fundraiser to support the financial health of the team.
