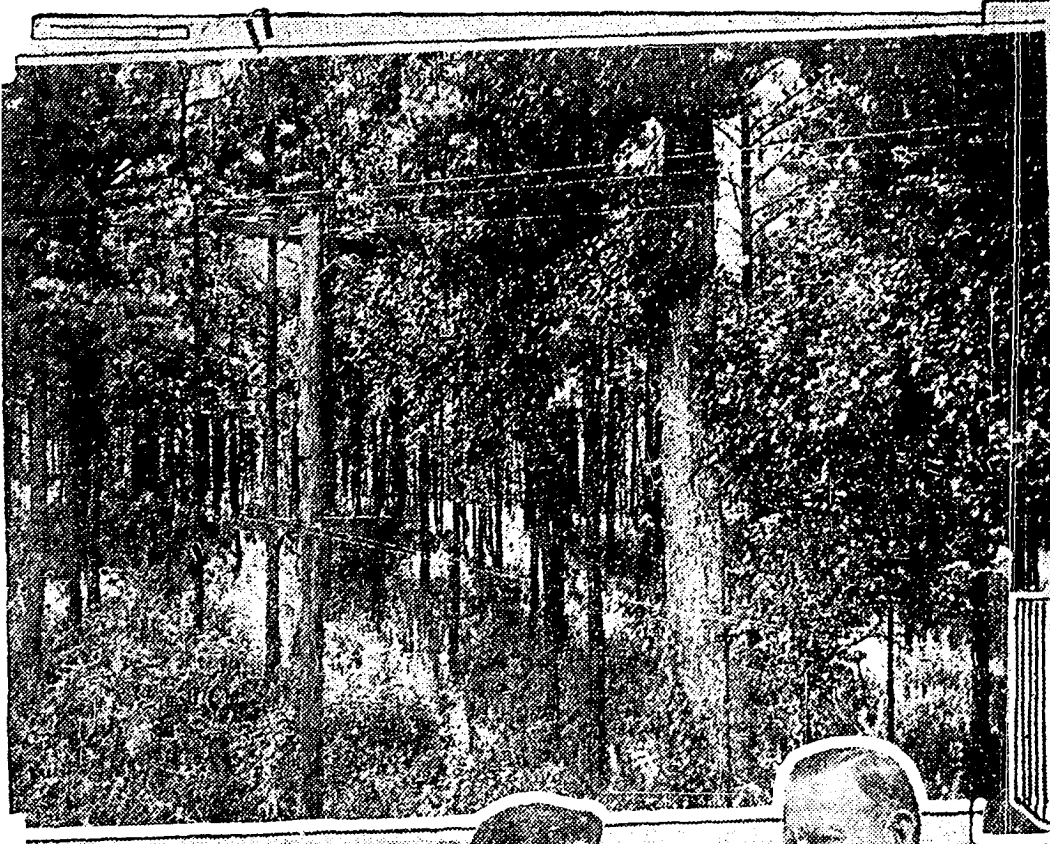


New Paradise for Golfing Fraternity Planned by Prominent Atlanta Men
