PETITIONS WOULD ZONE NORTHWEST DISTRICTS

Efforts to halt advance of business into several large areas in northwest Atlanta were under way yesterday as three petitions to zone the areas exclusively for residential purposes were filed with Frank R. Fling, clerk of the Fulton county commission.

The areas sought for zoning include a portion of Brown's Mill road, near the intersection of Harper road; a Collier Hills section between Twenty-eighth street and Collier Road, and a Garden Hills section between Peachtree road, East Wesley avenue, Piedmont road and Rumson road. Fling said the petitions would not be considered until the September meeting of the commission.
