## LEADING RADON TESTING LABORATORY ENTHUSIASTICALLY ENDORSES NEW YORK'S PROPOSED "RIGHT TO HOME INSPECTION ACT" (S. 8729-A)

**Atlanta, Georgia — May 19, 2026** — As New York State considers landmark consumer protection legislation, Radalink, Inc., a premier independent analytical laboratory specializing in radon measurement, today announced its full endorsement of Senate Bill 8729-A, also known as the "**Right to Home Inspection Act**".
