MEASUREMENT FORM

What You Need

- Print this form
- Blank paper & a pen/pencil for foot tracings
- Flexible/soft measuring tape (cm's)
- Socks & breeches you normally wear riding
- A helper will make it easier

These three measurements are must haves for standard boots sizes.



#1 Foot Size Europe

- Stand square on a blank sheet of paper
- Ensure your weight is evenly distributed on both feet
- With a pen held upright trace around the contour of each foot
- On your foot tracing draw a line from the tip of the toe to the heel and measure in cm

#2 Widest Part of Calf

- Locate the widest part of your calf
- Move the tape up and down a bit to identify the widest point (be careful and always check the tape is straight around your legs) and record your width cm.

#3 Leg Height

- Slightly bend your leg and locate the crease behind your knee
- With the measuring tape held straight (not following the contour of your leg) measure the distance from the ground to the crease of your knee in cm

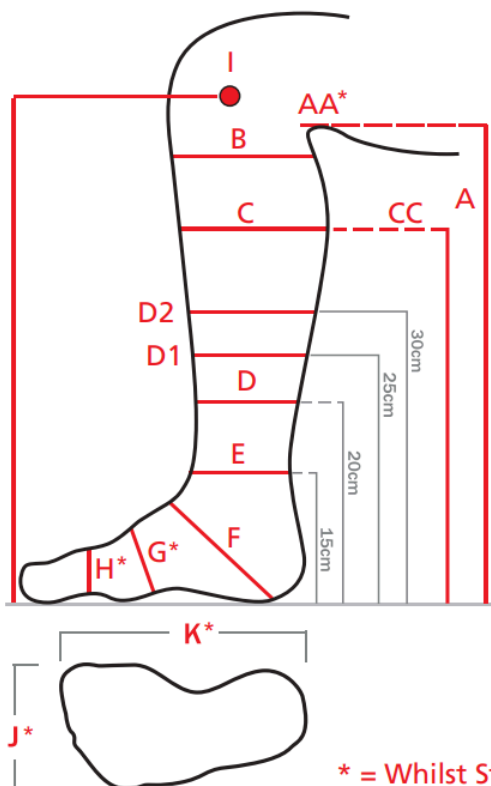

* = Whilst Standing

All measurements should be taken over normal breeches/socks (in Centimetres)

- A - Height- whilst sitting from the crease at the back of the knee.
- AA - Height – whilst **standing** from crease at back of knee straight down to the ground.
- B - Circumference of the leg just under the knee.
- C - Circumference of the leg at the widest part of the calf.
- CC - Height to the widest part of the calf.
- D - Circumference of the leg at the point 20cms up from the ground. (or 25cm-D1 or 30cm-D2)
- E - Circumference of the leg at a point 15cms up from the ground.
- F - Circumference at the position marked
- G - Circumference at the position marked whilst **standing**
- H - Circumference at the position marked whilst **standing**
- I - Height to the Knee Knob
- J - Width of foot whilst **standing**
- K - Length of foot whilst **standing**
