#### **Eastview High School**

The 330,000 square foot facility is built to house 2,000 students in grades 9-12 and offers: state-of-the-art classroom design with built-in monitors, VCRs, satellite connection, telephones and LAN/WAN connections; a technology infrastructure that includes building-wide wireless hubs and nearly 900 network/Internet connections with room for additional growth; a 5:1 student to computer ratio; computers, voice mail and e-mail for all faculty and staff; a 650 seat Performing Arts Center with a fly loft and scene shop; a dedicated dance studio and full-time, curricular dance program; four gyms with a running track surrounding the main gym; a 4,500 square foot strength, conditioning and fitness center; a two-level media center with computerized library research capabilities and fullyequipped television and digital editing studios.
