

Eastview High School, the district's fourth comprehensive high school, opened in September 1997. Eastview High School is located in Apple Valley, adjacent to 200 acres of playing fields and recreational facilities. The 330,000 square foot facility is built to house 2,000 students in grades 9-12 and offers: state-of-the-art classroom design with built-in monitors, VCRs, satellite connection. telephones and LAN/WAN connections; a technology infrastructure that includes building-wide wireless hubs and nearly 900 network/Internet connections with room for additional growth; a 5:1 student to computer ratio; computers, voice mail and e-mail for all faculty and staff; a 650 seat Performing Arts Center with a fly loft and scene shop; a dedicated dance studio and full-time, curricular dance program; four gyms with a running track surrounding the main gym; a 4,500 square foot strength, conditioning and fitness center; a two-level media center with computerized library research capabilities and fullyequipped television and digital editing studios.

Matt Ladd is a self built athlete. His character and work ethic have enabled his to set high goals and work tirelessly to meet them. Ladd has led the JV


team in all statistical categories at one time or another and is ready for more time on Varsity.

Edgar will be a force for the Lightning at 220 and 285. He had a full season on varsity last year and is working to crank things up this season as a senior leader and an athlete.




To be a winner you must be willing to make sacrifices. This means maintaining good training habits, getting the proper amount of rest, and eating a balanced diet.
