Kaizen: Continuous Improvement

2022-2023 Eastview Wrestling

In sport we are always looking for ways to improve our skills and techniques. Each season at Eastview Wrestling we have a team motto or mantra that we use as motivation during the long season. Kaizen: Continuous Improvement is this year's axiom that we will adhere to.

Kaizen Definition: A Japanese word that means "continual improvement." It's a philosophy that says you can never get everything right the first time, and there's always room for improvement. It's a philosophy of continuous improvement in your systems and processes. The idea is to keep improving day-to-day at every step of the process. Kaizen means making small improvements throughout the day, every day.

Continuous improvement that will lead us to reach our team and individual goals on the mat, and in life. Striving for improvement each time we practice and in the classroom.

Many wrestlers have skills or techniques that they are adept something that they do better than the average athlete, yet those skills need to be worked on as much as those pesky trouble areas. There is a common saying in sports, "Improve 1% each day", this is very similar to Kaizen, except using the continuous improvement does not 'limit' one by a measurable amount. We will seek out those areas and times where we can improve.

We can look at our international wrestlers showing examples of continual improvement.

David Taylor is one of the most decorated collegiate and international wrestlers of our time.

There is a video of Taylor at an early age where during an interview he said that he lost a lot during his first year of the sport but kept improving and coming back for more. He wrestled in high school in Ohio where he was a four-time state champion going 182-2 AND graduated with a 4.0 GPA. He wrestled collegiately for Penn State where:

He was 4X Big Ten Champion for Penn State University. Taylor was a 2x NCAA Champion, (4X finalist) and voted two times as the best college wrestler. Hodges Trophy winner (Wrestling's Heisman trophy).

He finished his career with 134 wins 3 losses with 50 pins and 42 tech falls. Dominate. He has gone on to a stellar international freestyle career.

After graduating, he entered the Senior Level international ranks, however, he could not beat Kyle Dake and Jordan Burroughs, both outstanding mainstays of the United States Team. After working on his craft, he met up with Burroughs in 2021 for a Flo Wrestling event and finally bested the 5-time World Champion!

There are YouTube videos of David working out, always seeking to improve his wrestling, his technique, being inventive - even after a devastating knee injury, he looked for ways to continuously improve.

Many of us are not going to be a David Taylor, that is not the point. The point is he worked very hard for what he has earned and for where he is now.

Watching matches on video, coming in early to the room, staying late, watching what we put into our bodies, are all ways to continually improve. Moreover, developing this mindset will permeate to other areas of our lives, and after the headgear is taken off for the final time, Kaizen: Continuous

Improvement will be ingrained into our daily lives.



The 2021-2022 Wrestling Season was the **Inaugural MSHSL Girls Wrestling Post Season**

irls Wrestling is the fastest growing sport in the nation. There are more than 21,000 female wrestlers competing. $oldsymbol{I}$ The MSHSL was the 32nd high school association in the country to offer a girls' wrestling program.

Eastview's **Riley Myers** and **Elsie Olson** had been wrestling for years, but they competed against boys. The 2021-2022 season offered the first all girl wrestling tournaments and sections and a State Championship! Both Elsie and Riley took their experience wrestling boys and made their mark on the inaugural girls wrestling state championships.

"The more I think about all of this, the more exciting it gets," Riley said. "Knowing that we are part of history and part of when girls wrestling was starting to grow is really cool. And hopefully more girls become interested."

"It was really exciting and not anything I got to experience before. Knowing it was the first time in history was like nothing I've ever felt before. It was bigger than anything I ever participated in because we were making history. It took a while for it to sink in that I got to be a part of something so awesome and special."

What was it like walking out on the XCEL floor for the first time and seeing all the mats and fans?

"It was slightly overwhelming. I definitely turned bright red. It was probably the most unique experience of my life and something I hope to experience again this year and years to come."









Riley Myers - 1st Place State 2022

Do you remember when you first heard they were going to sanction girls wrestling and what was that moment like?

"It was very exciting because now more girls would be joining and the sport was going to be growing."

What are you most proud of when you think of being a part of the first ever Girls Wrestling State Championship?

"Honestly, the entire thing just being able to be a part of that first group of girls and making that statement and setting the level basically for future girls for future state tournaments. Being a part of the first tournament makes me proud because that's something that can't be taken away. Like winning state, sure people can try and take that title away from you, but they cannot take away being the first one!"

When you think back on winning the state title, what stands out most to you?

"When I think back to that memory of winning state it's the crowd, the big audience and being at the XCEL energy center and also being with the boys because they are all competing in the same place for a championship. This year we were all together."

Nick Fornicoia – Head Coach

Coach Nick Fornicoia is entering his 26th year teaching at Eastview High School. This is Coach Fornicoia's first year as Head Coach of the Eastview wrestling team. He is an English teacher and teaches journalism classes. Fornicoia leads *The Flash*, a weekly news magazine show, which won multiple Student Emmy Production Awards last year. He also advises the award-winning Yearbook. In 2010, Nick was recognized as Minnesota Journalism Educator of the Year. Nick wrestled for Augsburg University and captured an individual National Championship. He finished his career as a three-time All-American. In his era, the Auggies placed second, first, second, and first in four national tournaments. Coach Fornicoia has been recognized as State Assistant Coach of the Year and has head coaching experience. Nick Fornicoia is Bronze certified by USA Wrestling. ple smile and lift others up. Chris will make a big difference in the world one way or another. Peace and positivity.




Shannon Rainey – Strength Coach
