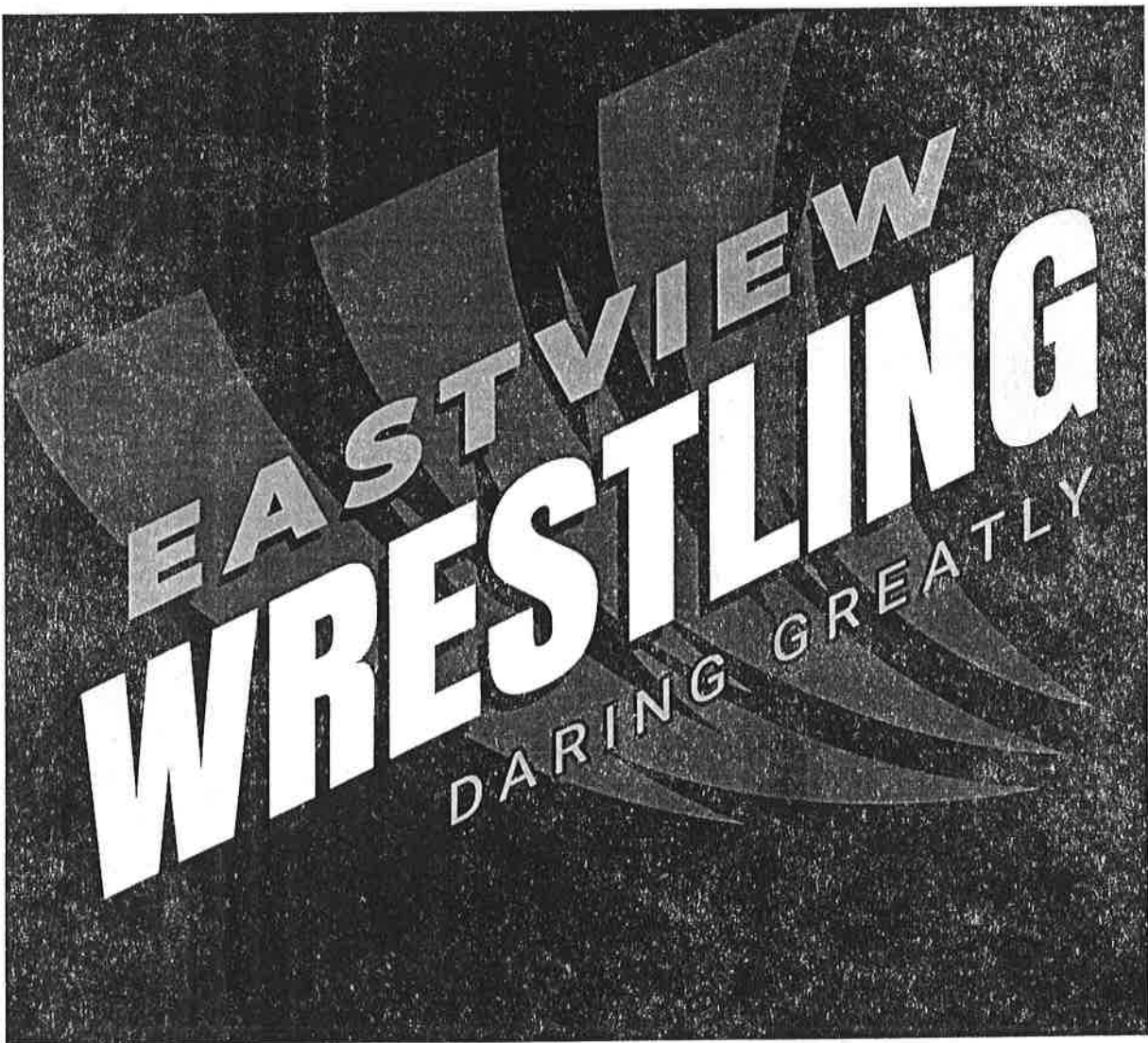

TEAM 2025: Daring Greatly!

Congratulations to each of the wrestlers for successfully completing the season. Eastview Wrestling season's motto was: **Daring Greatly!** Team 2025 focused on embracing courage, setting ambitious goals, giving full effort and struggling well!

Team 2025 participated in intensive wrestling training sessions, super group, and off-season freestyle competitions. Many wrestlers attended camps or clubs outside of Eastview. All of the accomplishments this year were directly related to the hard work of our athletes as they strived to continually improve.

The Eastview wrestling team embraced the motto Daring Greatly! To dare greatly means to wrestle not just for victories, but for the pursuit of excellence, the bonds we build as a team, and the lessons learned through both triumph and adversity. Below are a few highlights of the 2025 season.

The Freshman Team...

- ◆ Had 14 freshman and 2 middle school wrestlers learn the sport and compete during the season.
- ◆ Earned 2 dual meet victories including a 6th place finish in the Section 4 Dual Schedule.
- ◆ Had 3 wrestlers place at individual regions.
- ◆ Earned 39 match wins, 179 team points, 20 falls, and 79 takedowns.

The Junior Varsity Team...

- ◆ Earned 10 dual meet wins and placed 5th in the South Suburban Conference Tournament.
- ◆ Placed 1st at the Eastview Duals and had 15 wrestlers place at the SSC Tournament.
- ◆ Had 12+ wrestlers provide the depth needed to fulfill the varsity team's needs.
- ◆ Earned 242 match wins, 1244 team points, 169 falls, and 405 takedowns.

The Girls Team...

- ◆ Had 9 wrestlers learn the sport and compete during the season.
- ◆ Competed in 7 Girls tournaments, 4 Girls earned 1st place
- ◆ Had 2 wrestlers place at individual sections.
- ◆ Earned 66 match wins, 362 team points, 55 falls, and 97 takedowns.

The Varsity Team...

- ◆ Earned MN Academic Gold Recognition with a team GPA of 3.80.
- ◆ Had 9 wrestlers earn All-Conference and 3 earn All Conference Honorable Mention Honors.
- ◆ Placed 8 wrestlers at Individual Sectionals with 7 placing in the top 3 & 7 earn Academic Recognition.
- ◆ Had 4 State Qualifiers with 2 earning All-State honors at the State Championships.
- ◆ Had 23 wrestlers get an opportunity to wrestle on varsity with 13 wrestlers earn at least 10 wins.
- ◆ Earned 253 match wins, 1330 team points, 165 falls, and 450 takedowns.

The Class of 2025 includes 13 dedicated wrestlers who experienced many successes while living the mottos: Embrace the Corner, Kaizen, Into The Storm, and Daring Greatly. The senior class will graduate having earned 1,215 wins, 715 falls, 1,977 takedowns and 6,572 team points.

As we close the chapter on the 2025 season, we look ahead to what's next. The Senior Class of 2026 must ask themselves—how good do I want our team to be? How much am I willing to sacrifice to make it happen? Success in this sport is never given, only earned.

The work we put in over the next 11 months will define us. Champions are built in the off-season, when no one is watching—when it's just you, your goals, and the decisions you make every single day. 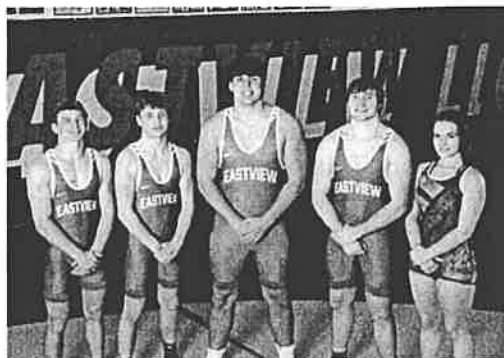

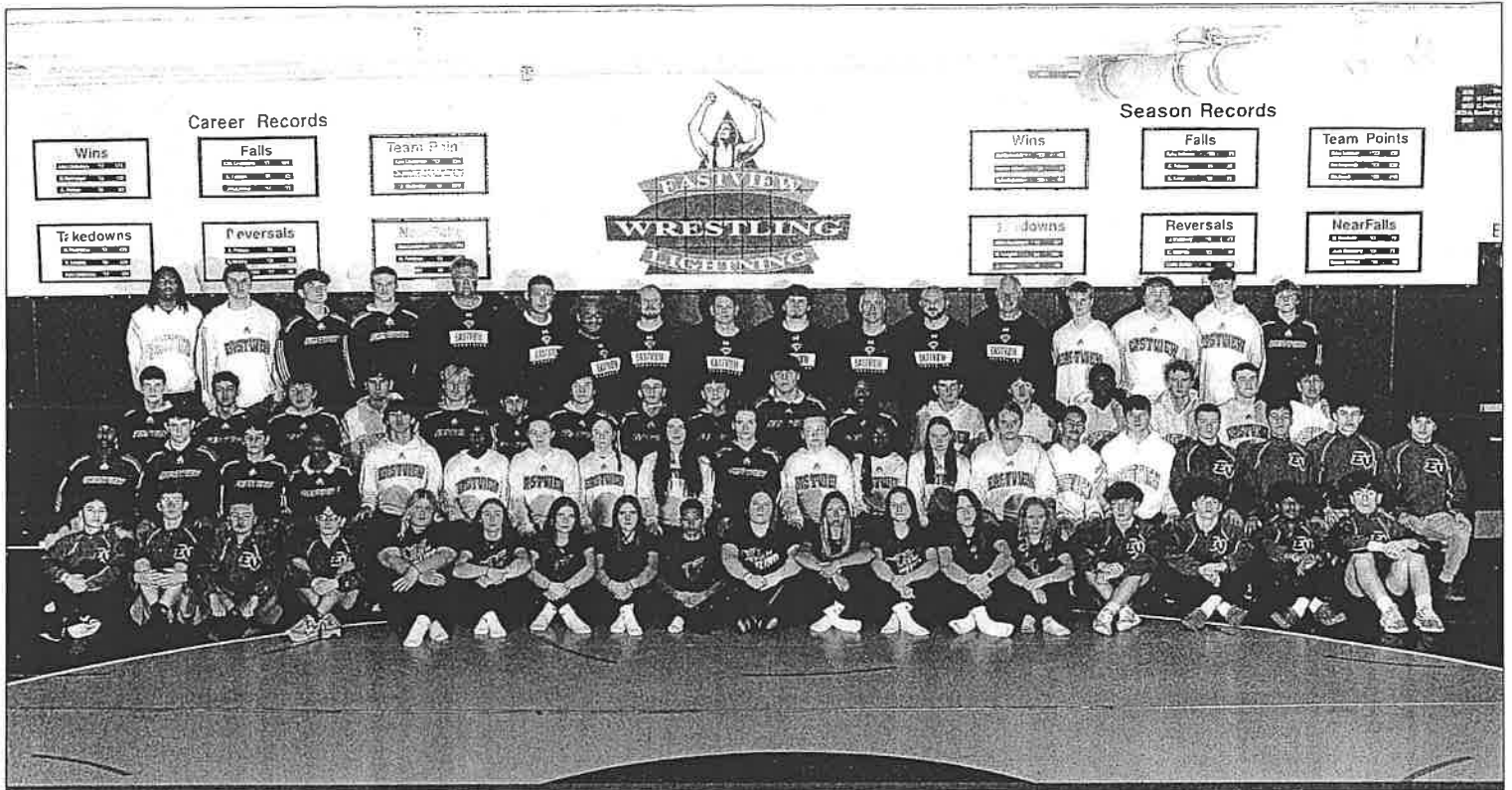

This season and in life, we are not timid. We are fearless. We are Daring Greatly!

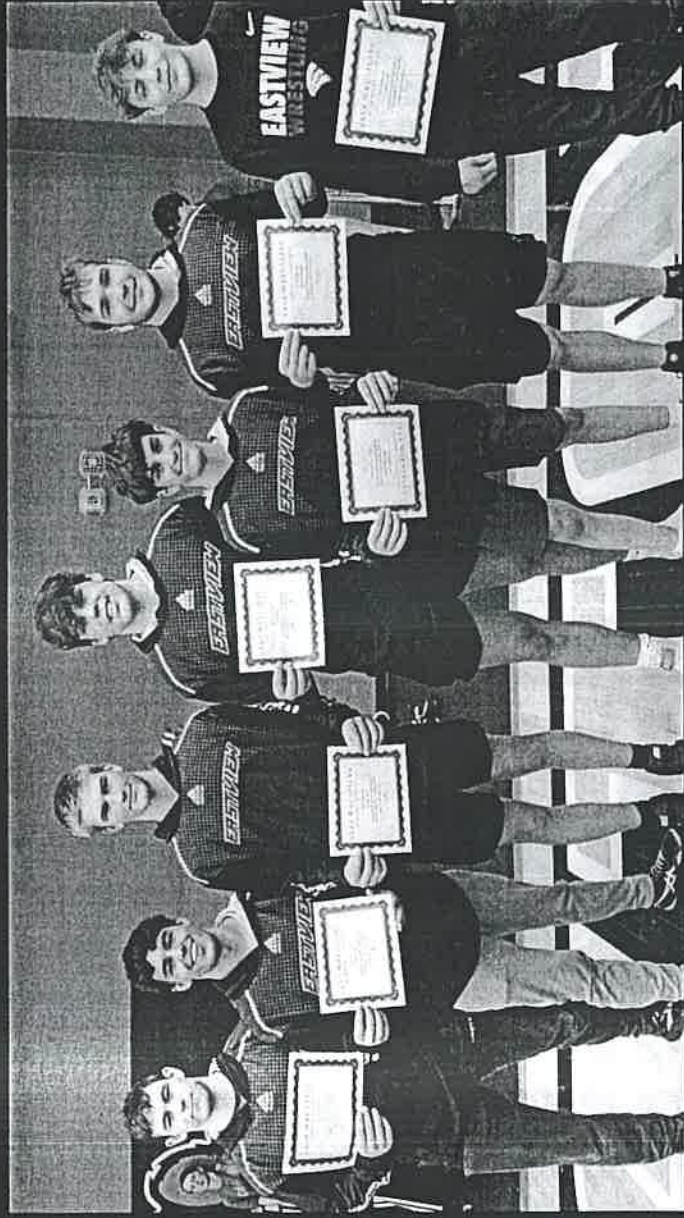

Wrestling: Tigers' Parrow seeks another state title

State Class 3A individual tourney starts Friday

Two champions from the previous Class 3A boys high school wrestling season won their brackets at the Section 2 tournament and are back at the state meet looking for more gold.

One of those champions is Farmington junior Davis Parrow, who ran his record to 41-1 by winning three matches — two by fall and one by technical fall — in the Section 2 individual tourney Feb. 22 at Farmington High School. Parrow won the Class 3A 139-pound championship in 2024.

Last year's Class 3A 107-pound champion, Prior Lake's Liam Collins, won the 114-pound bracket in this year's Section 2 tourney.

The 26 state individual qualifiers that made it through Section 2 include five from Apple Valley, four each from Farmington and Eastview, three each from Rosemount and Lakeville North, and one from Lakeville South. Wrestlers from Burnsville, Prior Lake and New Prague also competed.

State individual competition begins at 9 a.m. Friday at Xcel Energy Center. Class 3A quarterfinals are

4 p.m. Friday. The medal rounds start at 4 p.m. Saturday with third- and fifth-place matches in all three boys classes as well as the girls tournament. Championship matches follow the matches for third and fifth place.

One of the more anticipated championship matches of the Section 2 tournament was between Parrow, ranked first in Class 3A at 145, and fourth-ranked Louis Prouty of Apple Valley. Each wrestler went in with just one loss for the season. Parrow won by fall in 4 minutes, 24 seconds. Both wrestlers advance to the state tournament, where they could meet in the second round Friday.

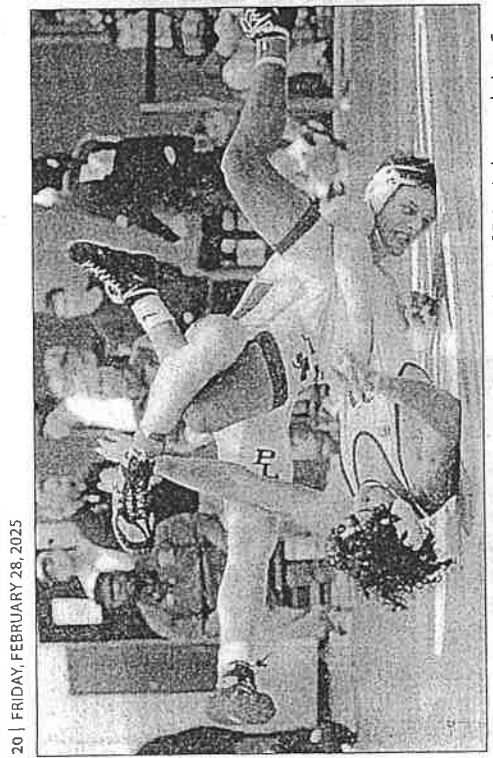
The Class 3A 285-pound rankings are stacked with South Suburban Conference wrestlers. In the Section 2 finals, No. 2-ranked Brock Zurn of Prior Lake defeated third-ranked Jack Bauer of Eastview 4-2. Zurn and Bauer move on to state, but 10th-ranked Syvonte Miller of Burnsville does not after losing a 5-1 decision to Bauer in the semifinals. Miller went on to take third place.

Also advancing to the state Class 3A 285-pound bracket is Eagan senior Cole Will (11-1), who's ranked first and won all three of his matches in the Section 3 tournament by fall in the

first period.

Will is one of two top-ranked wrestlers from Eagan to make the state tournament. The other is senior Dylan St. Germain, who qualified at 114 after being state runner-up at 107 last season. St. Germain takes a 36-3 record into state.

The girls state individual tournament will take place Saturday, with girls and boys medal-round matches running simultaneously. Apple Valley junior Cassandra Gonzalez is 22-0 going into state and is the favorite in the 142-pound bracket. She is a two-time state champion.

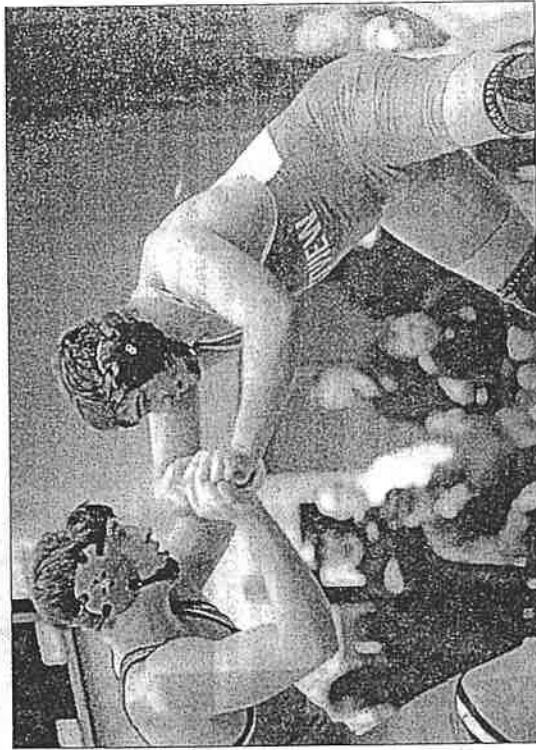
