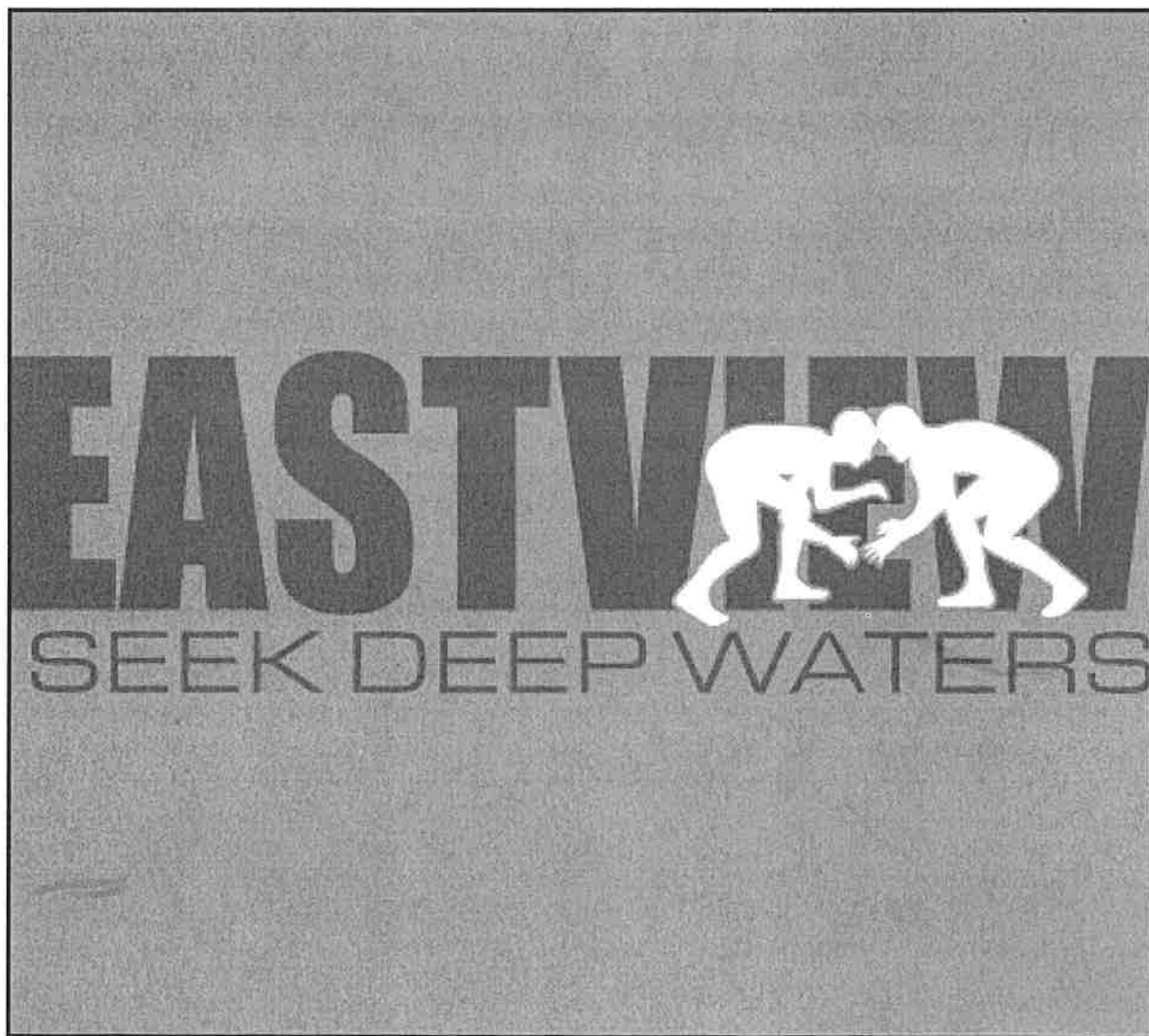

Congratulations to each of the wrestlers for successfully completing the season. Eastview Wrestling season's motto was: **Seek Deep Waters!** Team 2026 focused on embracing courage, setting ambitious goals, giving full effort and struggling well!

Team 2026 participated in intensive wrestling training sessions, Missouri Team Camp, super group, and off-season freestyle competitions. Many wrestlers attended camps or clubs outside of Eastview. All of the accomplishments this year were directly related to the hard work of our athletes as they strived to continually improve.

The Eastview wrestling team embraced the motto Seek Deep Waters! In essence, a team that seeks deep waters is comfortable in uncomfortable situations. To Seek Deep Waters means is a mental and physical strategy to work hard and push past our limits. Below are a few highlights of the 2026 season.

The Freshman Team...

- ◆ Had 15 freshman and several middle school wrestlers learn the sport and compete during the season.
- ◆ Had 4 wrestlers place at individual regions.
- ◆ Earned the opportunity to wrestle on the Junior Varsity several times.

The Junior Varsity Team...

- ◆ Earned 9 dual meet wins and placed 6th in the South Suburban Conference Tournament.
- ◆ Placed 1st at the Eastview Duals and had 16 wrestlers place at the SSC Tournament.
- ◆ Had 13+ wrestlers provide the depth needed to fulfill the varsity team's needs.
- ◆ Earned 189 match wins, 1018 team points, 143 falls, and 334 takedowns.

The Girls Team...

- ◆ Had 10 wrestlers learn the sport and compete during the season.
- ◆ Competed in 8 Girls tournaments, Girls earned 1st or 2nd place 17 times
- ◆ Had 5 wrestlers place at individual sections.
- ◆ 4 wrestlers earned All-Conference
- ◆ 2 wrestlers earned section championships and were state qualifiers
- ◆ Earned 88 match wins, 495 team points, 79 falls, and 129 takedowns.

The Varsity Team...

- ◆ Earned MN Academic Gold Recognition with a team GPA of 3.80.
- ◆ Had 6 wrestlers earn All-Conference and 2 earn All Conference Honorable Mention Honors.
- ◆ Placed 11 wrestlers at Individual Sectionals with 7 placing in the top 3 & 9 earn Academic Recognition.
- ◆ Had 4 State Qualifiers with 1 earning All-State honors at the State Championships.
- ◆ Had 22 wrestlers get an opportunity to wrestle on varsity with 8 wrestlers earn at least 10 wins.
- ◆ Earned 285 match wins, 1409 team points, 173 falls, and 598 takedowns.

The Class of 2026 includes 16 dedicated wrestlers who experienced many successes while living the mottos: Kaizen, Into The Storm, Daring Greatly, and Seek Deep Waters. The senior class will graduate having earned 634 wins, 330 falls, 1,099 takedowns and 2,929 team points.

As we close the chapter on the 2026 season, we look ahead to what's next. The Senior Class of 2027 must ask themselves—how good do I want our team to be? How much am I willing to sacrifice to make it happen? Success in this sport is never given, only earned.

The work we put in over the next 11 months will define us. Champions are built in the off-season, when no one is watching—when it's just you, your goals, and the decisions you make every single day. 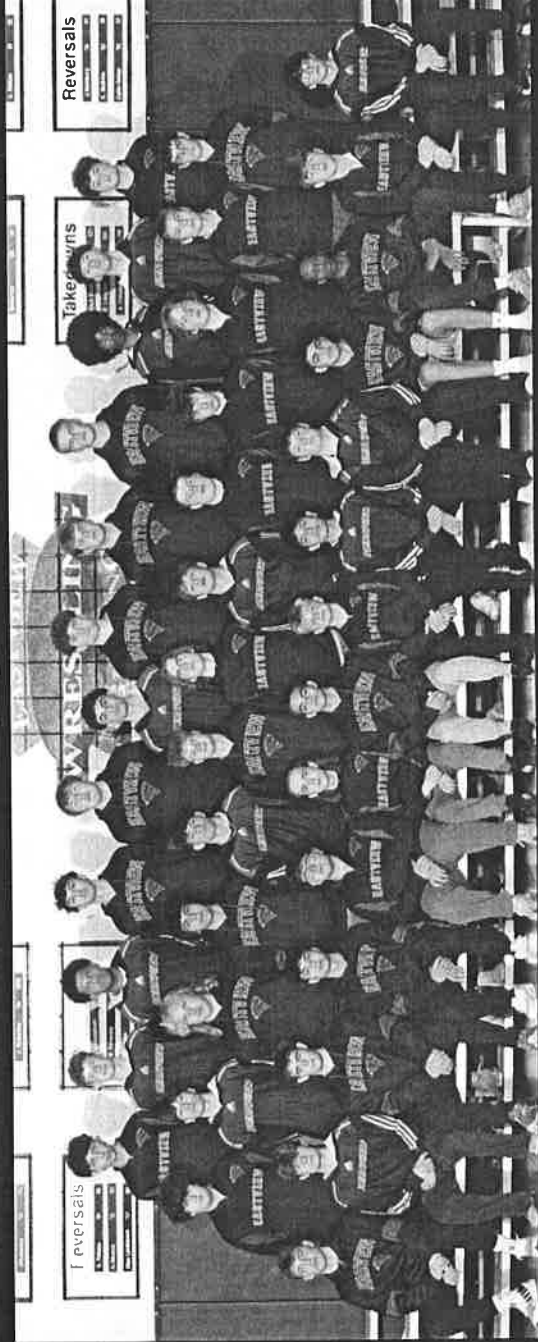
Joy, Struggle Well, Faith Over Fear, Serve Others, Full Effort, and Practice Gratitude Daily.

SSC roundup: Top-ranked wrestlers from two states collide at Rochester tourney

Tigers' Parrow takes second at Minnesota Christmas Tournament

No. 1-ranked wrestlers from two states met in the 152-pound final at the Matboss Minnesota Christmas Tournament last weekend in Rochester.

That feature match was between Farmington senior Davis Parrow, ranked first in Minnesota Class 3A, and Kellen Wolbert of Oconomowoc High School, ranked first at 150 pounds in Wisconsin's Division 1. Wolbert scored a takedown early in the first period and held his lead the rest of the match, winning 4-1. Parrow's point came on an escape in the third period.

Wolbert, a senior and three-time Wisconsin state champion, remained undefeated this season at 17-0. Parrow, a Minnesota state champion in 2024 and two-time runner-up, lost for the first time in 15 matches. They'll move on to the Big Ten Conference next year — Parrow to Nebraska and Wolbert to Michigan.

Parrow's runner-up finish led Farmington to 24th place of 48 teams that scored points in the Minnesota Christmas Tournament. Two other teams from the Dakota County Tribune/Sun Thisweek coverage area competed — Eastview, which finished 18th, and Apple Valley, which placed 31st.

The top five teams at the tournament were basically a roll call of highly ranked Minnesota programs — St. Michael-Albertville (first in Class 3A), Stillwater (second in Class 3A), Shakopee (third in Class 3A), Kasson-Mantorville (second in Class 2A) and Watertown-Mayer (sixth in Class 2A).

Parrow won his other four matches at the Minnesota Christmas Tournament, two by decision, one by major decision and one by technical fall. He faced Easton Dircks of Brainerd (ranked third in Class 3A at 152) in the quarterfinals and won 4-2.

Two other Farmington wrestlers placed in the top 12 at the tournament. Ethan Mangowi (15-2) placed fifth at 160 and Blake Han-Lindemyer (8-3) placed 10th at 133.

Eastview had five top-12 finishers, including senior Spencer Lee, who was fifth at 139. He went 4-2 in the tournament and is 13-2 this season.

Pierce Lewis, an Eastview senior, finished sixth at 172 and is 11-4 this season. Senior Ryan Layeux (12-4) finished seventh at 285. Aiden Frost (215) and Aryan Karimnejad (133) placed 12th in their weight classes.

Top finisher for Apple Valley was senior Riley Clark (17-3), who placed seventh at 172. Eagles junior Saitaro Kong (17-5) finished eighth at 121.

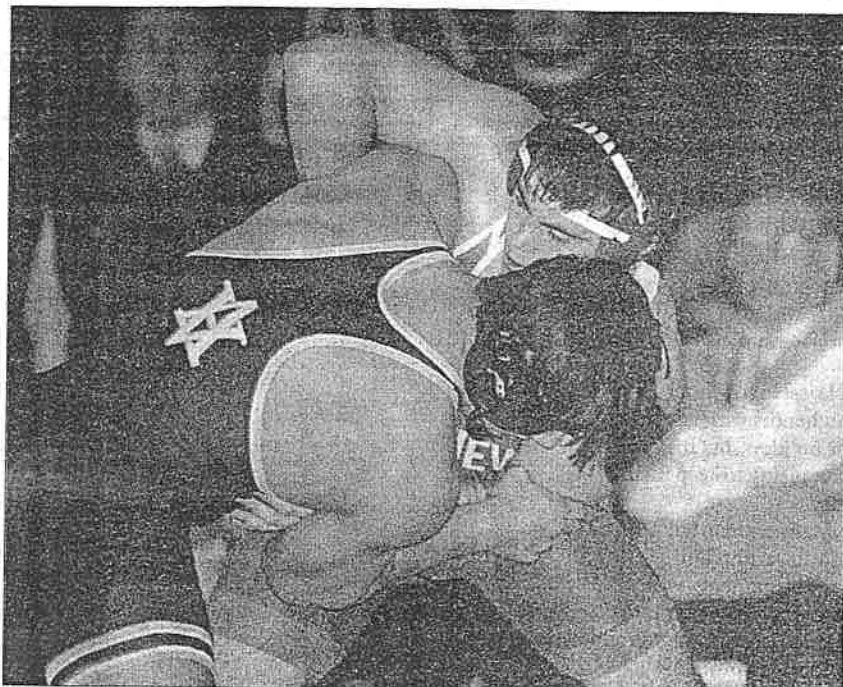

WRESTLERS TO WATCH

Locally, one of the storied of the 2025-26 wrestling season will be Farmington senior Davis Parrow's bid to win a second state championship in three years. Parrow, a University of Nebraska commit, is 94-3 in his last two high school seasons. He defeated Charles Vanier of Eden Prairie to win the Class 3A 139-pound state championship in 2024 and was runner-up to Vanier in the 145-pound final last season. Vanier is now at the University of Minnesota,

so Parrow will have a different opponent if he makes the state final again this season.

Parrow, who also was a state runner-up as an eighth-grader and a third-place finisher as a freshman, placed sixth in freestyle in his weight class at the USA Wrestling nationals in July.

Eastview's Spencer Lee is back for his senior season after finishing fourth at state in the Class 3A 133-pound bracket last season. He is ranked sixth at 139 this year.

Eagan sophomore Evan

St. Germain will try to follow in the footsteps of his brother Dylan and win a state championship. Evan qualified for state at 107 last season and is ranked seventh at 121 this season. Dylan won a state championship at 114 last year as a senior and is now wrestling at Southwest Minnesota State.

In addition to being a three-time state girls champion, Apple Valley senior Cassidy Gonzalez is 72-0 in high school matches. She's ranked first in the state at 142 this season. Esperanza Calvillo,

also an Apple Valley senior, was a state runner-up last year and is ranked second at 155. Sophomore Andrea Quinones is ranked second at 124.

Eagan junior Ellie Westerman is ranked fourth at 124 after finishing second at that weight last year. The defending champion at that weight, Simley junior Charli Raymond, is the only four-time state champion in Minnesota high school girls wrestling.

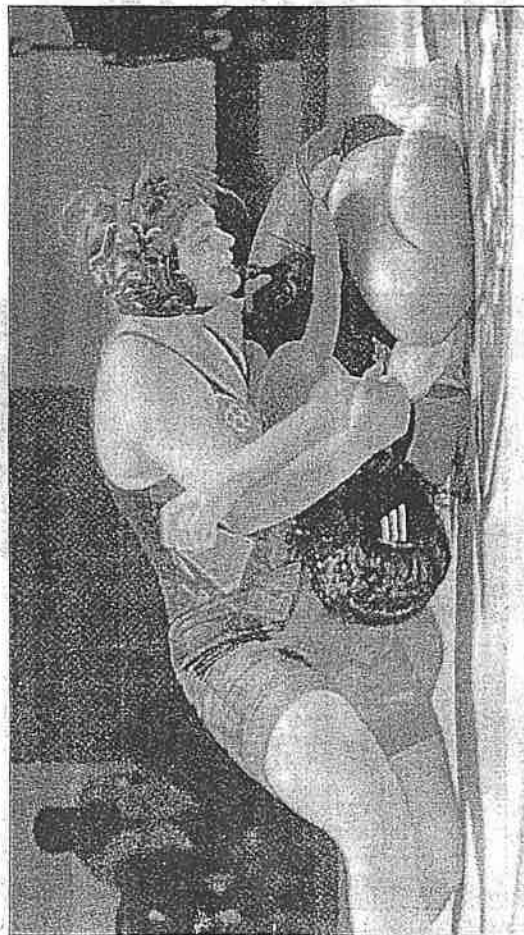
