Experience keys Eastview grapplers

It's not easy being a member of the Eastview wrestling team.

First of all, you're program has only existed for three seasons. Second of all — and this is a big one — the high school down the street, Apple Valley, has won two state wrestling titles in those three seasons and five of the last eight.

That's a tough tradition to contend with.

Yet, early indications are that the 1999-2000 season will be a breakout one for the Lightning. With eight regulars back from a 6-14-1 team, Eastview may have the firepower to move into the upper half of the Lake Conference. The Lightning placed seventh last year.

"This is our most experienced team in school history," third-year head coach Kurt Habeck said. "We have good senior leadership. We expect to finish in the top half of the Lake Conference."

While Apple Valley has received most of the attention, teams such as Lakeville, Eastview and Farmington have quietly been putting together good seasons. The Panthers are 4-1 since the new year, the Lightning are enjoying their best season ever at 8-1 and Farmington is above .500 at 6-5.

Burnsville, Rosemount and Eagan have struggled to put together team victories, but coaches are happy with the individual improvement of many of the wrestlers.

With regional competition about six weeks away, wrestlers are still looking to improve on the season and be ready to make a run in late February and hopefully still be around in early March.
