

Congratulations for your commitment, hard work, and courageous efforts to succeed. The season was filled with many highlights for each team and the wrestling program as a whole. At last year's banquet, we celebrated a very successful year - 18 varsity wins, being ranked in the top ten in state, and having a senior class that provided great leadership along the way. The success in the 2000-2001 season appeared to very unclear. The coaching staff challenged each returning wrestler to make a commitment to work hard in the off season. The challenge was obviously met. The success we had this year was a direct result of the efforts made in the off season. Team 2001 was not only prepared in the beginning, it continued to work hard and improve throughout the entire season.

Reflecting on this past season brings back many positive memories. The season officially began with the 2nd annual commitment night. What a great event to allow a team filled with underclassmen to come together, set goals, build relationships, and begin establishing trust in each other. Below is a recap of the 2000-2001 season.

The **freshman team** had an outstanding season filled with many highlights....

- ◆ The largest freshman team in history with 34 completing the season.
- ◆ 8 dual meet victories and qualifying for the team state tournament.
- ◆ Dominating the individual regional tournament and qualifying a record 10 individuals to state.
- ◆ Becoming STATE CHAMPIONS in the individual tourney with 2 champs and 7 place winners.

The **junior varsity team** also had a record breaking season having multiple wrestlers compete for each spot...

- ◆ A team that became more prestigious to be on as the season progressed.
- ◆ A school record 17 dual meet wins.
- ◆ Earning 2nd place at the Lightning Invite.
- ◆ Defeating a state power Owatonna team who had not lost in over 2 years.
- ◆ Providing the depth needed to fulfill each of the varsity teams needs.

The **varsity team** was challenged from the very beginning. Our goals were to make history and finish better than any other Lightning wrestling team...

- ◆ Earning 14 hard fought victories and being competitive with each team wrestled.
- ◆ Accomplishing a team goal and having 6 individual tournament champions.
- ◆ Having 11 wrestlers place at the section individual tournament with 2 champions.
- ◆ Qualifying 4 wrestler's to the state tournament - setting a school record.
- ◆ Having 2 state place winners and Eastview's 1st male STATE CHAMPION.
- ◆ Accomplishing a team goal of becoming a State Academic Team with a 3.68 GPA.

The **class of 2001**, the Elite Eight, has paved the way while accomplishing many great things. The senior class leaves having earned 240 wins, 123 falls, 1181 team points - all calculated by our senior manager. To each of the seniors, I thank you for your hard work, commitment, and your ability to achieve things nobody would have believed. My hope for you is that you continue to use these life long skills to achieve great things. You are always welcome in our wrestling room.

I share with you some final thoughts about the future of Eastview Wrestling. The future of Eastview Wrestling appears to be very bright. However, I remind you of a very well known proverb, *Success is a Journey, not a Destination*. The success that our wrestling program will have in 2002 is dependent on the amount of commitment, hard work, and sacrifice made during the off season. With that being said, **I challenge each of you make a commitment, become a leader, and work hard**. Eastview is a program that is ready to take the next step in the journey of becoming STATE CHAMPIONS!



COURAGE TO SUCCEED



If desire is your wishbone, then courage is your backbone. Your backbone gives you the gumption, the get-up-and-go, the guts to excel the incentive to make any dream you dare to dream come true.

It's easy to be ordinary or mediocre, but it takes courage to excel, to be different from the crowd. That's why not many people can do it. The rewards are great, but so are the risks. It takes courage to sacrifice; to work long, hard hours when you could be relaxing; to work out when there are so many distractions; to seek out tough competition when you know you'll probably get beaten. It's easy to be average, but it's hard to be the best.

It takes courage to stand by your convictions when all those around you have no convictions.

It takes courage to keep fighting when you're losing.

It takes courage to stick to your game plan and the unrelenting pursuit of your goal when you encounter obstacles.

It takes courage to run a marathon, but then how would you ever know how far you could run if you never tried?

It takes courage to try to be the very best you can be when others around you settle for mediocrity.

I firmly believe we are put on earth to be tested—to be challenged with adversity and to see what we can accomplish. The successful person is the one who continually faces the problems and challenges that life brings—and overcomes them all, no matter what the obstacle is.

I also believe that most people have far more courage


than they give themselves credit for. When tested, people find they have the courage to look deep into their souls; and do things they never thought possible. This amazes most people, who initially don't believe they have much courage. We all have it—we just don't realize it.

Most people are completely unaware that they possess this type of courage. Why? Because if they were aware of it, they'd have to test it—and that's risky. So most people play it safe and don't risk "Going for it." They're afraid of going into the unknown. There are no guarantees.

Unfortunately, people frequently tell you things can't be done before they tell you things can be done. They're what we call "SNIOPs"—people who are "Susceptible to the Negative Influences of Other People." It's easy to be negative because it's safe and deals with the known. It's hard to be positive because it means taking risks and deals with the unknown. It takes courage to succeed.

Sebastian Coe used the word "courage" to describe what it will take to run the su-

per mile. He didn't say mental toughness—which is what you need at the end when your legs are dead and your lungs are bursting. Most good athletes can handle this; they can fight through the pain barrier. What Coe is saying is that you must be courageous—you must be brave enough to push yourself at the beginning when you're not hurting, knowing full well that by doing this, the more you'll hurt at the end. That is courage!

Fokken Tale

Adam Fokken transferred to Eastview as a freshman and has made an impact ever since

Tales of Adam Fokken swirled through the halls of Eastview High School the moment the wide-eyed freshman walked through the doors four years ago.

Already a well-known wrestler from his days on the Eagan High School varsity team, Fokken quickly became a recognizable figure at the new school without any seniors.

A stout 15-year-old, at nearly six feet and 150 pounds, Fokken already cast a large shadow.

But nothing like the one he'll leave when he graduates this spring.

Arguably the most dominant athlete ever to don the black, blue and white, Fokken's folk hero-like story at Eastview has gotten even greater, in this his senior season.

Fokken is currently the No. 1 ranked 189-pound wrestler in Class AAA, the first-ever Lightning wrestler to hold this esteemed honor. He's unbeaten at 13-0, including a 3-1 win over No. 2 ranked Chad Mentel of Austin.

A two-time state qualifier, Fokken finished fourth at state last season and is the highest returning place-winner at 189 pounds this year.

This past fall, Fokken was named an honorable-mention all-state defensive lineman in football, and in the spring, he participated in the discus at the state track meet.

The most frightening thing — his potential is still relatively untapped.

"There isn't anything he can't do," said Eastview head wrestling coach Kurt Habeck, who also coached Fokken as an eighth-grader at Eagan. "Our program has basically developed around him. He's been a leader on this team and at this school since he got here. He made an impact on this building as a freshman."

"He's quiet, yet everybody knows who he is."

Fokken's departure from Eagan wasn't because he saw a better opportunity for himself at Eastview. That had nothing to do with it.

Instead, it was because he lived in the

boundaries of the new school. The thought of going somewhere else never crossed his mind.

He doesn't have a 3.9 grade point average for nothing.

"Eastview was the school I was assigned to," Fokken said, "so that's where I went."

The Eastview wrestling team struggled mightily in its first season, finishing with a dismal 3-18 record.

The lone bright spot — Fokken.

He won more than 20 matches that first year and finished fourth at sections. In a post-season tournament, he won the ninth-grade state championship at his weight class, the first of many championships to come.

As a sophomore, Fokken became the first Eastview wrestler to qualify for the state tournament. He followed that with 34-7 record last season and a fourth-place finish at state, in the process becoming the all-time winningest wrestler in Eastview history.

He has a 122 career wins.

Incredibly, all the records, success and exposure hasn't changed Fokken one bit. He's still as down-to-earth as the smirky freshman who arrived four years ago.

"I try to be a positive role model for all the young kids," said Fokken, who's still considering his college options. "I don't focus too much on what I've done up to this point. I'm always looking ahead. I know there's a lot more I have to learn."

Fokken's impact on the Eastview wrestling community cannot be overstated. Considering the school rests just minutes east of a wrestling Mecca, otherwise known as Apple Valley High School, it was very important that the Lightning were able to have a wrestler of Fokken's caliber for four years.

So important, the effects will be felt even after he is long gone.

"I cringe every time I write down senior next to his name on the lineup card, because I know soon he'll no longer be here," Habeck said. "It's definitely going to be different."

"Long after he's gone, the memory of Adam will still be here."

In the 119-pound match, Steve Davis stretched the Lightning's lead to 8-3 with a 11-2 victory over Colin Voigt.

Down 8-3, Rosemount won the next three matches to regain the lead at 13-8. The Irish's Andy Cox started the streak as he defeated Jon Hanson 11-5. In the next match at 130 pounds, Chris White defeated Sean Dwyer 3-2 in a hard-fought match.

Rosemount pushed its lead to 13-8 when Adam Montour defeated Adam Johnson 15-5.

Eastview came right back in the 140-pound match and tied the competition at 13 when Ryan Langlais scored a 19-4 technical fall over Ken Francois.

Blake Nicolay of Rosemount

defeated John Getzke 4-2 to give the Irish a 16-13 lead going into the final five matches.

Eastview's David Rasmussen won a 16-4 major decision over Rosemount's Zac Cornett to give the Lightning a 17-16 lead. Again Rosemount answered with a 5-1 victory by Kris Blommel at 160 pounds over Eastview's Chris Shuck.

With the score 19-17 in favor of the Irish, Eastview needed to win two of the final three matches to advance. Eastview did just that when Eric Lemm defeated David Walls 6-5 at 171 pounds, and Adam Fokken clinched the Lightning victory with a pin over Mike Carbone to give the Lightning a 26-19 lead with one match left.

Rosemount's heavyweight

Brian Fox defeated Brian Putnam 10-4 to end the match with a Lightning 26-22 victory.

"We didn't give up falls. We gave up a three-point decision and that's what won us the dual," Habeck said.

Eastview

The Eastview Lightning's wrestling season came to an end with a 45-9 loss to Apple Valley.

"Against Apple Valley, I thought we wrestled pretty darn good," Habeck said. "There were several matches that could've went either way."

One of Eastview's only victories against the Eagles was by 135-pound Sean Dwyer. He defeated Tom LaCombe 6-4 with a late takedown.

"It was a good win for Sean," Habeck said.

The other victory was when the No. 1-ranked 189-pound wrestler, Eastview's Adam Fokken, pinned Mike Holtgren.

A couple of the close matches came earlier in the competition as the Lightning's 112-pound wrestler Mike Fornicoia lost to Neil Wasmund by one point and Steve Davis at 119 pounds lost in overtime.
