TEAM 2007: STORM THE MAT!

Congratulations to each of the wrestlers for completing the season. This past off-season, Team 2007 worked hard, made sacrifices, and developed an attitude in preparation to **Storm the Mat!** The season was filled with many highlights for each team and the wrestling program as a whole. At last year's banquet, we said good-bye to 9 quality seniors. The senior class of 2007 was not big, however, were determined to achieve high standards set by previous teams. Team 2007 committed to several off-season training programs including participating in another sport, wrestling freestyle, strength training in Super Group, and traveling to Nebraska for a team camp. The success that each team had this year was directly related to the leadership provided by the seniors and by each individual making a commitment to the team. The successes we had this year is something that each wrestler and parent should be very proud of.

Reflecting on this past season brings back many **positive memories**. Commitment Night led by the seniors allowed each wrestler to come together, build relationships, set goals, and begin making a commitment to the upcoming season. The two senior captains did a great job leading by example, promoting a solid work ethic, and encouraging each wrestler to maximize their efforts. Below is a recap of the 2007 season.

The Freshman Team...

- ◆ Had 26 eager wrestlers learn the sport and developed into a team while completing the season
- ◆ Improved throughout the season, placing 2nd in their section and having 8 wrestlers place at Regions.
- ◆ Earned 13 dual meet victories including an 8th place finish in the 9th Grade State Team Tournament.
- ◆ Qualified 4 individuals to the 9th grade State Tournament with three state place winners.
- ◆ Earned 254 match wins, 1270 team points, 137 falls, and 298 takedowns.

The Junior Varsity Team...

- ◆ Earned 13 dual meet wins and a 4th place finish in the Lake Conference.
- ◆ Competed in the 1st Annual Lake Conference JV Tourney and earned 3rd place honors.
- ◆ Earned twenty individual tournament championships.
- ◆ Earned 224 match wins, 1154 team points, 137 falls, and 280 takedowns.
- ◆ Provided the depth needed to fulfill the varsity team's needs; 16 freshmen had a chance to wrestle JV.

The Varsity Team...

- ◆ Earned Academic Gold recognition with a team GPA of 3.64.
- ◆ Earned 13 hard fought victories including Eastviews first Faribault Invitational Championship.
- ◆ Had 8 wrestlers earn All Conference Honorable Mention and 1 earn All Conference Honors.
- ◆ Became the first to defeat a higher seed at Team Sections as well as to have 14 Section Place Winners.
- ◆ Had 34 wrestlers get an opportunity to wrestle on varsity with 9 wrestlers earning at least 15 wins.
- ◆ Earned 324 match wins, 1553 team points, 171 falls, and 555 takedowns.

The **Class of 2007** includes 6 highly dedicated seniors who together **STORMED THE MAT** with vengeance. The senior class will leave having earned 193 wins, 90 falls, and 872 team points. To each of the seniors, we thank you for your hard work, commitment, and your ability to achieve things nobody would have believed. We wish you the best of luck in your future endeavors and we hope that the Lightning Pride you developed over the past 4 years will be with you forever.

I want to share with you some final thoughts about the **Future of Eastview Wrestling**. The **Coaching Staff** is more committed than ever to make improvements needed to the overall program. We have many goals that have yet to be achieved. **Wrestlers** need to challenge themselves even more than those before them, inspire teammates to work harder, make greater sacrifices, and do all the little things needed to become a champion. **Parents** must continue to offer their support and work with the wrestlers and coaching staff to **Raise The Bar**. I'd like to say that the quality of any man's life is a full measure of that man's personal commitment to excellence and to victory, regardless of what field he may be in.

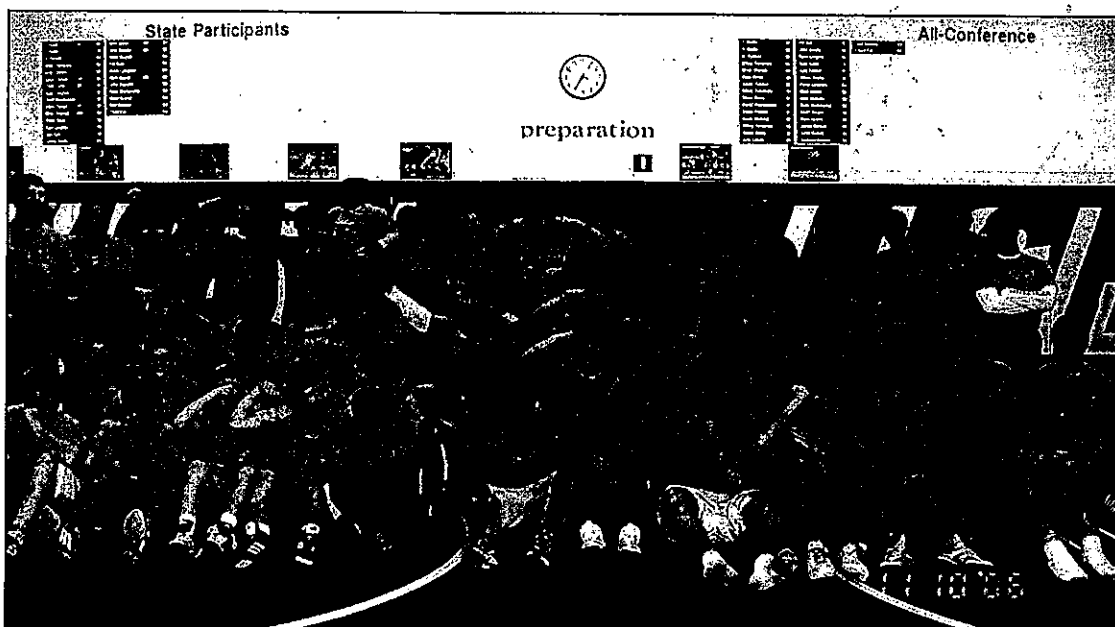
"Commitment"

Dan Getzke lost by technical fall in his opening match to Forest Lake's Luke Munkelwitz and then lost to Owatonna's Matt Uher.

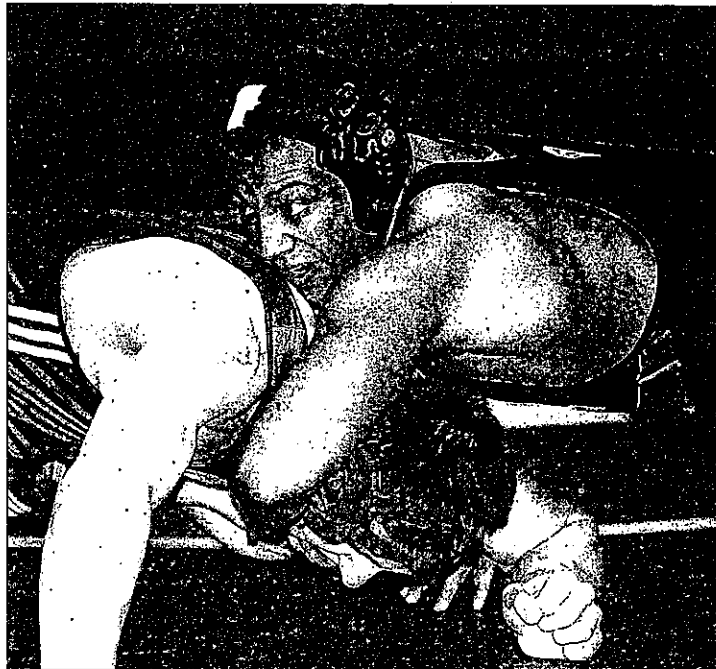
