# EASTVIEW WRESTLING

## TEAM 2019: STOP AT NOTHING!

Congratulations to each of the wrestlers for successfully completing the season. Eastview Wrestling's season motto is: "**Stop at Nothing**". Team 2019 committed to several off-season training programs including attending freestyle practices, participating in wrestling training sessions, super group, and attending the Missouri Team Camp. All of the accomplishments this year were directly related to the leadership by the seniors and their ability to "**Stop at Nothing**"!

The Eastview wrestling team worked hard to establish a **Predator Mindset** and develop a tunnel vision to attack their opponents. Predators focus on the things they can control in order to be successful. Eastview wrestlers are asked to live, train, and compete based on four **Mindset Principles**: 1 - *I am thankful for the opportunity to wrestle.* 2 - *I am aggressive and relentless.* 3 - *I have no fear of losing or making a mistake.* 4 - *I never ever give up.* The senior class and captains did a great job leading by example, promoting a solid work ethic, and promoting the mindset principles. Below are a few highlights of the 2019 season.

### The Freshman Team...

- ◆ Had 16 freshman and 4 middle school wrestlers learn the sport and compete during the season.
- ◆ Earned 6 dual meet victories including a 4th place finish in the Section 4 Dual Schedule.
- ◆ Earned 3<sup>rd</sup> place at the Eastview Duals & Qualified for the 9<sup>th</sup> Grade State Team Tourney
- ◆ Had 4 wrestlers place at individual regions and 2 wrestlers qualify for 9<sup>th</sup> Grade League State.
- ◆ Earned 88 match wins, 441 team points, 58 falls, and 140 takedowns.

### The Junior Varsity Team...

- ◆ Earned 11 dual meet wins and placed near the top in the South Suburban Conference.
- ◆ Placed 2<sup>nd</sup> at the Eastview Duals and 8 wrestlers placed at the JV Conference Tournament.
- ◆ Several individuals were able to participate in varsity tournaments during the season.
- ◆ Earned 185 match wins, 992 team points, 137 falls, and 274 takedowns.
- ◆ Had 8+ wrestlers provide the depth needed to fulfill the varsity team's needs.

### The Varsity Team...

- ◆ Earned MN Academic Gold Recognition with a team GPA of 3.74.
- ◆ Earned 16 hard fought victories placing 1<sup>st</sup> at the Eastview Duals & 1<sup>st</sup> at the Trinity Invitational.
- ◆ Had 4 wrestlers earn All-Conference and 3 earn All Conference Honorable Mention Honors.
- ◆ Placed 7 wrestlers at Individual Sectionals with 6 placing in the top five.
- ◆ Had 1 State Qualifier and 2 Wrestlers earn Section Academic Recognition.
- ◆ Had 21 wrestlers get an opportunity to wrestle on varsity with 14 wrestlers earn at least 13 wins.
- ◆ Earned 327 match wins, 1682 team points, 168 falls, and 558 takedowns.

The **Class of 2019** includes 7 wrestlers who lead the team with a single minded focus it takes to be successful in wrestling. The senior class will leave having earned 338 wins, 149 falls, and 1695 team points. To each of the seniors, we thank you for your hard work, commitment, and your ability to achieve things nobody would have believed. We wish you the best of luck in your future endeavors and we hope that the Lightning Pride you developed over the past 4 years stays with you forever.

As we begin preparing for next season, the **Senior Class of 2020** must ask themselves - How good do I want our team to be? The leadership the seniors provide over the next 12 months will ultimately determine Team 2020's success! **Being the Best** is a common goal that championship teams work together toward! If teammates are not putting forth consistent effort, we need to pick them up and encourage them to carry on! If teammates are having poor attitudes, we'll be there to pump them up and give our support. **Section 2AAA** is consistently the top achieving section in the state. In order for Eastview to raise the bar and achieve more, each of us must commit to make the need changes. 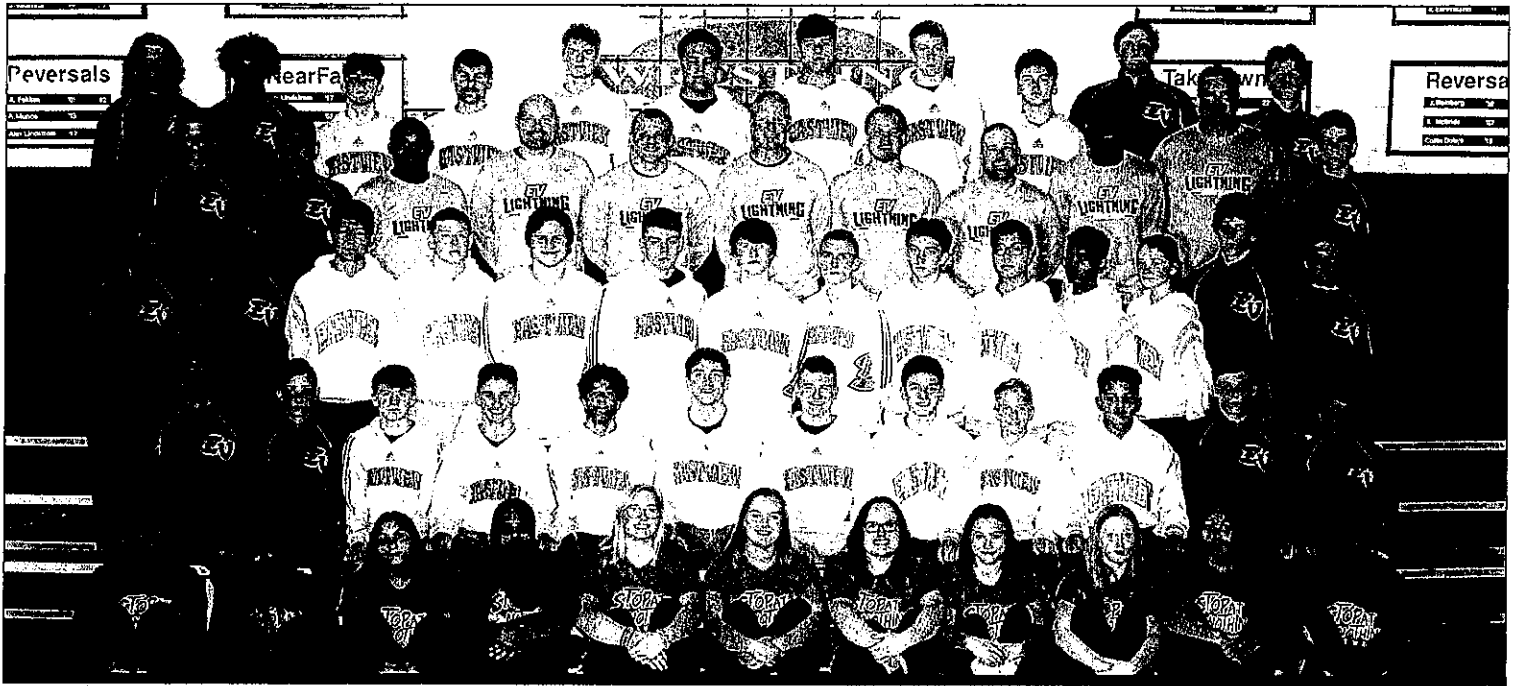

# Stop at Nothing!

STOP AT NOTHING means...  
*"To do whatever it takes to accomplish a task or goal."*

Fairly simple and straight forward definition. Putting this phrase into action is where many run into difficulty.

Everyone has goals in life, be it personal, educational, spiritual, relational, etc. These goals can be long term-longer than a few months to accomplish; or short term-daily, and/or weekly. There are many obstacles that can get in the way to reach said goals—for our wrestlers STOP AT NOTHING is going to be the mindset to facing those obstacles head on; sacrificing to reach individual and team goals.

**SACRIFICE**—Wrestlers, to be successful in life, you must be willing to sacrifice and be disciplined and STOP AT NOTHING to reach your goals. When your friends are out late and you have a morning practice on a Saturday, do you go home early? Are you willing to watch what you put in your body to optimize your health? Are you willing to manage your studies? Are you willing to STOP AT NOTHING to reach your goals?

It is no secret to success now days—hard work, discipline, sacrifice...ask yourself. Are you willing to STOP AT NOTHING to reach your goals?

*Examples of athletes who stopped at nothing to be their best:*

Jamill Kelly was born in Atwater, California, where he attended Atwater High School and placed fourth in the state wrestling tournament as a senior. He spent one year at Lassen Community College then transferred to Oklahoma State where he became a three time letter winner. Even though he never won a state high school tournament or a national title in college, Kelly did win the 2004 USA Nationals and the US Olympic trials at 66 kg (145.5 lbs) to represent the US in Athens. After winning both pool matches 3-0, he defeated eventual bronze medalist Makhach Murtazaliev of Russia in the semifinal, 3-1. In the gold medal match, Kelly faced Ukrainian Elbrus Tedeyev. Tedeyev would win the gold 3-1, leaving Kelly with the silver.

Former NFL QB Kurt Warner was one of the biggest underdog stories in American sports history. He went from sacking groceries at a grocery store, to becoming a Super Bowl winning quarterback in the NFL.

Former MLB pitcher Jim Abbott was a talented athlete, but he had one glaring problem. He was born without a right hand. The ex-California Angels pitcher didn't let this bother him, as he still was able to win 87 games in his 11-year big league career. He also pitched a No-hitter.

Anthony Robles was born without a leg, but he didn't let that stop him from becoming a national high school and college wrestling champion. He began his career on the mat in his high school. His first match as a small 90-pound freshman was less than epic, he got better and then became the best. In March of 2011, the All-American Arizona State University student won the NCAA championship title for the 125-pound weight class division.
