Application rules:

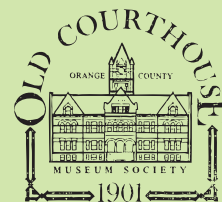
- One page paper, typed, single spaced, 12 point font, 1 inch margins
