Overview

The purpose of the fund is to provide assistance to individuals when representing Tasmania at national sporting events.

Who can apply?

If you are under the age of 18 or competing in an under 18 event, living in Bass and have been selected to represent Tasmania in sport.

Sponsorship available

A successful applicant may receive up to:

Event location Tasmania \$50 per individual

Interstate \$100 per individual Overseas \$150 per individual

Conditions

- · All applicants to live in Bass
- Applicants must agree to acknowledgment of sponsorship from The Janie Finlay Representative Sports Fund.
- Applicants must agree to the use of social media photos taken before, during, and after the event.

Limitations

Individuals can only receive sponsorship from the Janie Finlay Representative Sports Fund once each financial year, with any one individual to only receive sponsorship of up to \$300 in a lifetime.

Application criteria and process

Applications must be received at least four (4) weeks prior to the event. Applications received after this time will be ineligible.

Applications for sponsorship from the fund must be submitted to <u>Janie.Finlay@parliament.tas.gov.au</u>.











Your application is required to include:

- · A copy of your letter of selection.
- · Parent/guardian name and address/s for proof of residency in Bass.
- · A brief overview of how this would help you attend.
- Social media and photo consent from parent/guardian.
- If your sport does not have a Tasmanian state team but you have been selected to represent another state please provide information to support your application.

Assessment process

- · Applications will be processed within 4 weeks and in the order they are received.
- All applications are reviewed by The Janie Finlay Representative Sponsorship Fund volunteer committee to ensure they meet eligibility requirements and all relevant information has been provided. This committee reviews applications weekly.
- Decisions are made under approval of Janie Finlay and are subject to the available funds.
- Applications outside of the criteria may be considered at the discretion of committee if "exception to compete" documentation is provided.

Allocation of funds

Once an application has been approved, funds will be provided to successful applicants transferred to a nominated bank account.
