



He holds a MA in History and Spanish from Indiana University, has done post-Master's work at the University of Texas at Austin, and is the author of several scholarly publications. As a Certified Member of the Appraisers Association of America, PRB&M's David is a fully Qualified Appraiser for donors' IRS tax purposes. He



regularly performs appraisals as an integral part of PRB&M's business, often for donors of collections to universities and other special collections repositories, including, for example, Princeton, Penn, Columbia, Rutgers, Michigan, Villanova, Bowdoin, and Vanderbilt among others.


