


How to Install Optional PVC Legs and Gravity Drain System





MATERIALS LIST.

Parts that need to be purchased from your Local Hardware Store. (not included with your kit)



For Drain Line Coming from Planter. "Down Spout"



For Main Drain Line.



For Optional Legs. (4 Needed Per Planter)



Male threaded 3/4" to 1/2" Female Slip



Down Spout Drain Line. (1 Needed Per Planter)

For Connecting Drain Grommet to



For Connecting Individual Planter Drain Spouts to Main Drain Line. (1 Needed Per Planter Except End of Row)



For Connecting Drain Line Coming from Planter at the "End of the Row" to the Main Drain Line.

1" x 1" x 1/2" PVC Reducing Slip Tee






Optional: PVC Cement






STEP 1: Unpack planters and place them in desired area.



STEP 2: Raise your Ez-Pz PlantersTM to your desired height with 1-1/4" PVC under each corner.




PRO TIP: MEASURE TWICE, CUT ONCE!




STEP 3: Gently screw 1/2" PVC Street Elbow fitting into drainage grommet until no threads are shown.

STEP 4: Starting from the end of each row, working yourself towards your reservoir; cut each $\frac{1}{2}$ PVC $\frac{1}{4}$ Shorter coming out of the Drain line before it connects to your $\frac{1}{2}$ and 90 degree elbow.






STEP 5: Insert <u>1/2</u>" Female to 1" Female Elbow on end of row & 1" x 1" x 1/2" PVC Reducing Slip Tee as shown below.





STEP 6: Connect elbows and Tees Using 1" PVC and connect to reservoir for recycling or exterior waste water drain.
