We envision a world where every hospitalized child experiences the power of celebration and connection as part of their healing journey inspiring a shift in pediatric healthcare that recognizes joy as an essential part of recovery.







ORGANIZATIONAL OVERVIEW

Party With A Purpose Project is an innovative nonprofit that operates as an e-commerce platform providing pre-packaged, curated party bundles for celebrations of all kinds. These bundles are designed for both general consumers and hospitalized children, ensuring that all children—regardless of health status—can experience meaningful celebrations.

How It Works:

- E-Commerce Party Bundles: Customers purchase themed party bundles for birthdays, holidays, and special events, all packaged for groups of 10.
- Virtual Parties for Hospitalized Kids: Families, hospitals, or caregivers can purchase party bundles for children who are unable to have traditional celebrations due to medical restrictions.
- **Community-Driven Support:** A portion of the profits from party bundle sales goes toward funding donated parties for hospitalized children in need and granting wishes for Make A Wish kiddos.

This model allows Party With A Purpose Project to sustain itself financially while fulfilling its charitable mission.

As the sole funder of the nonprofit In 2024, I personally covered all operational costs, these expenses have been documented, and as revenue Is generated In 2025 and beyond, there Is a plan to reimburse startup costspending:

- Board approval of reimbursement plan.
- Sufficient financial stability of the organization.
- **⊘** Prioritization of mission-related spending first.

Reimbursement will be approached gradually and only If It does not Impact our ability to fulfill our nonprofit mission.

LOOKING AHEAD 2025 & BEYOND

SHORT TERM (2025)

Launch sales & marketing efforts via LinkedIn & other platforms

Donate at least 8 virtual party bundles to hospitalized children (2 per quarter)

Fulfill 30 gala donation bundles for national hospital fundraising events

Build brand awareness through hospital partnerships

MID-TERM (2026)

Fund a full Make-A-Wish experience (\$12,000 goal)

Expand marketing and hospital partnerships

LONG-TERM (2027+)

Establish a scholarship for students pursuing pediatric research

Fund a university research grant focused on pediatric healthcare advancements
