Battery Warranty Terms & Conditions

Warranty Exclusions - Situations Not Covered

The following battery failures are not covered under warranty, as they result from misuse, neglect, or improper handling not manufacturing defects.

1. Deep Discharge (Battery Voltage Below 10.5V)

A voltage reading below 10.5V means the battery was not charged for an extended period, leading to irreversible sulfation.

Verification:

- Battery reads under 10.5V after attempted recharge.
- Fails to hold a charge after slow charging.
- Instant voltage drop during load test.

2. Physical Damage (Cracks, Leaks, Broken Terminals)

Damage from impact, acid spills, corroded or broken terminals.

Verification: Visual inspection for external damage or leakage.

3. Improper Charging

Using non-compatible chargers or overcharging damages the battery.

Verification: Check charger used and inspect for heat or deformation.

4. Freezing Damage (Cold Weather Storage in Discharged State)

Leaving battery discharged in cold leads to freezing and cracking.

Verification: Cracked case or freeze marks.

5. Lack of Maintenance Charging (Extended Non-Use)

Long-term storage without charging leads to irreversible damage.

Verification: Serial/date code and voltage trend.

Warranty Coverage - What's Covered

Defects caused by manufacturing faults or abnormal early failures.

1. Dead Cells or Internal Shorts (Early Life Failure)

Battery reads constant ~10.5V despite charging or self-discharges quickly.

Verification: Load test and voltage check within 30 days.

2. Premature Capacity Loss (with Proper Use)

Noticeable range drop within warranty period despite proper use.

Verification: Controlled discharge test vs factory specs.

3. Seal or Terminal Manufacturing Faults

Leakage or broken terminals without signs of misuse.

Verification: No external damage observed.

General Conditions

- Warranty applies to original battery from Kapla Huaihai.
- Duration: 12 months from sale (proof of purchase required).
- Replacements do not reset warranty period.
- Kapla reserves the right to inspect/test before claim approval.
