Balloon Rides

Wind is the most critical factor in safe ballooning;
More balloon inflations are cancelled due to wind than for any other reason. Balloons inflate best in light and stable winds of 4-6 miles per hour.

Balloon Rides will begin as soon as the Balloon Pilots have determined it is safe. Please bring your waiver to the ticketing booth to purchase a ticket when they announce the rides are starting.

Balloon Glow

After 8pm, the pilots inflate their balloons and blast the propane burners, which releases a burst of fire into the balloon. The balloons "glow" like huge fireflies. The Balloons do not launch during the Balloon Glow & Laser Show.

If weather conditions are optimal the crowd line will be lowered and and spectators will be invites to walk around to enjoy the view and chat with pilots and crew.
