

January LUNCHEONS AT - A - GLANCE

EASC plans luncheons every Wednesday from late August through the month of May. We work with the Culinary program at the Center for Technology - Essex (CTE) for soups provided at the hosted meal-site luncheons or for Friday soup & sandwich days. 1st Wednesday: Luncheon held at EASC. Sandwiches and desserts are provided by sponsoring churches in the community. Soup is provided by the Culinary program at CTE. The lunch on 1/8 is sponsored by Holy Family and Grace Methodist Church. Early sign-up is requested; this meal costs \$2/member, \$4/non-member.

<u>2nd Wednesday:</u> Luncheon is held at Essex Middle School; We are invited to a delicious meal through the Child Nutrition Services of the school district. \$3/member, \$4/non-member
