EASC plans luncheons every Wednesday from late August through the month of May. We work with the Culinary program at the Center for Technology - Essex (CTE) for soups provided at the hosted meal-site luncheons or for Friday soup & sandwich days.

1st Wednesday (this month): EASC will take part in the Thanksgiving Luncheon hosted by the Essex Parks and Recreation and the Essex Junction Recreation and Parks. Tickets are \$13/person and must be purchased in advance at the Parks and Recreation office at 75 Maple Street office. The luncheon will be held at Holy Family and will be catered by the Center for Techology Essex Culinary Program.

<u>2nd Wednesday:</u> Luncheon held at EASC. Sandwiches and desserts are provided by sponsoring churches in the community. Soup is provided by the Culinary program at CTE. The lunch on **11/13** is sponsored by St. Pius Church. **Early sign-up** is <u>requested</u>; this meal costs \$2/member, \$4/non-member.

<u>3rd Wednesday</u>: Luncheon is held at Essex Middle School; we are invited to a delicious meal through the Child Nutrition Services of the school district and students and school staff take very good care of us. Sign-up is <u>required</u> ahead of time by Monday 11/18. This meal costs \$3/member, \$4/non-member.

4th Wednesday: This month, we will have a cupcake party to celebrate all November birthdays! Bring your own bag lunch or just come for Cupcakes provided by the culinary program. Sign-up is requested ahead of time but not mandatory. There is no fee for this event, but donations are appreciated.
