OUR MISSION

To help families move from crisis to career using existing community resources by engaging community partners, training agencies on a collaborative case management system, and recruiting case managers to respond when a family is in crisis

ACCESSING SERVICES/ENROLLMENT

Direct services are provided onsite by 100 Families partner agencies. Enrollment is open-entry. Participants may enroll at any time. To be enrolled, clients are entered in the HopeHub collaborative case management system: Check the 100 Families box and the county in which services are being provided. Upload completed TANF Eligibility Form HopeHub is fully HIPAA compliant. To become a partner agency, contact your local County Coordinator.

PROGRAM

Participants will work with a Primary Provider and a Care Team. Participant progress is tracked in 13 Areas: Dental, Education, Financial Stability, Food, Legal, Housing, Recovery, Mental Health, Physical Health, Safety, Transportation, Employment and Childcare. Partners have access to additional resources such as Restore Hope's Court Resolution Team. A participant has successfully completed the program when they move out of crisis, into stability and have started on a career path that can provide them with a living wage
