Purpose

This exciting program is designed to expose the student to the overall training that is suitable to Ministry preparation. The candidate must have a high interest in Biblical-Linguistic studies because the student will be compelled to transcribe biblical words or expressions as the student studies towards a comprehensive program completion. This program will learn itself copiously to the student in the area of **passages in the** Old and New Testament studies that will further lay a solid ministry and academic foundation for the student who desires to be involved in greater works in the Kingdom of God in the area of **biblical languages**. The program will educate the student in the area of biblical words, philosophy, Ethics, Church History, the Doctrine of God and humankind, Evangelism, Pastoral studies, and Biblical Preaching.

Program Requirements

A Bachelor's degree from approved University, College or Seminary. It is a 90 credit-hours program. All assignments must be emailed to winninglifetheory@gmail.com.

MBS 310: Exegetically examine **Leadership requirements** in 1 Timothy 3:1-10. Use Greek words to explain *“trustworthy saying”, “heart”, “overseer”, “a noble task”, “above reproach”, “husband”, “temperate”, “self-controlled”, “respectable”, “hospitable”, “able to teach”, “not given to drunkenness”, “not violent but gentle”, “not quarrelsome”, “not lover of money”, “manage his own family”, “his children must obey him”, “not recent convert”, “good reputation”, “deacons, malicious takers, and dishonest gain.”*

MBS 320: Exegetically examine **Godlessness in the Eschatological Era** in 2 Timothy 3:1-9. Candidate must use Greek words to explain the following terms: “lovers of themselves”, “lovers of money”, “boastful, proud, abusive, disobedient to their parents, ungrateful, unholy, without love, unforgiving, slanderous, without self-control, brutal, not

lovers of the good, treacherous, rash, conceited, lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of God.”

MBS 330: Exegetically analyze the **Hall of Famers** in Hebrew 11:1-30.

BBS 340: Use published Books, Journals, and Articles to research the **Priesthood of Jesus Christ in the New Testament**. **Candidate must focus on the priesthood of Jesus Christ in the BOOK OF HEBREWS**.

MBS 350: (a) The **Judaizers** constituted a formidable opposition to the spread of Christianity in Galatia. Discuss their false gospel and outline Paul’s apostolic and evangelistic tools used to abate anarchy in the provinces.

MBS 360: The **Charlatans** in the Epistle of Thessalonians vehemently opposed and watered down Paul’s Gospel in the city of Thessalonica. Discuss the diabolical method used by the Charlatans, and Paul’s warnings against the false preachers.

MBS 370: Exegetically examine ***Christian Marriage*** in the New Testament and focus on 1 Corinthians 7:1-16.

MBS 380: Exegetically discuss the terms, ***world (kosmos), and love (agapetos)*** in the three ***epistles of John***.

MBS 390: The tongue is referred to as a small organ in James 3: 1-18, but wields the potency to annihilate territories, nations, kingdoms, and individuals. Discuss the power of the tongue in the chapter. Support your answer with perverse lips in the wisdom literature.

MBS 400: Discuss the major biblical themes in the book of Colossians and Highlight the following philosophies: “syncretism”, paganism, Judaism, and Greek philosophical ideas that permeated Christian truth in the Church.

MBS 410: The epistle of Philippians was written in prison to the Church in Philippi, Macedonia. Discuss factors that brought about massive magnitude of Joy to Apostle Paul. Emphasize their benevolent attitude toward him and the Christian Community.

MBS 420: Expound on the **universal call** of believers, and ministers, and support your answer with scriptures. Candidates must refer to published academic materials on the **universal call**.

MBS 430: Since the beginning of creation, **sex, money, and power** have contributed enormously to the advancement of humanity, **BUT** the three are considered the **axis of evil** of human endeavors. Expatiate on the repercussions of the **abuse of sex, power, and money**.

MBS 440: Describe the importance and significance of Christology in Christian belief, Christian doctrine, and Christology in the **New and Old Testaments**.

MBS 450: Discuss the prophetic office of Jesus Christ focusing on the Prophet Isaiah’s pronouncement about the birth and ministry of Jesus Christ. Candidate should focus on Isaiah 9:6-7. Use biblical language to explain the terms “***Wonderful Counselor, Mighty***”

God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace, he will reign on David's throne, over his kingdom, justice, righteousness, and the zeal of the almighty."

MBS 460: Use biblical language to explain the "**Year of the Lord's favor in Isaiah 61:1-11**. Candidate must focus on "*The Spirit of the sovereign Lord, anointing, good news to the poor, broken hearted, freedom for the captives, proclaim the year of the Lord's favor, grieve in Zion, a crown of beauty, the oil of joy, garment of praise, oaks of righteousness etc.*

MBS 470: Use biblical languages to expound on the **kingdom of God**. The candidate must use Hebrew, and Greek to explain the connotation of the kingdom of God in the Bible. The student must use "**The kingdom of God and its implication to the 21st century believers to understand the course. Order your book from www.winninglifepayerministry.com.**

MBS 480: Discuss the importance of Angeles in Christian ministry. Refer to the role of Angels in both the Old and New Testaments. Student must mention the relationship between angels and Jesus' birth and ministry, the creation of angels, the immortality of angels, and the organization of Angels.

CHURCH HISTORY

MBS 490: Discuss the development of Ante-Nicene Theology and highlight the following in your discussion:

- (a) Clement of Alexandria (c-150-215 AD)
- (b) Origen (c 184-254 AD)
- (c) Cyprian (c 200-258)
- (d) The conversion of Constantine (274/280-337).

MBS 500: Research the **LIVES and accomplishments** of the following **famous Church fathers:**

- (a) Ambrose 340-397 AD.
- (b) John Chrysostom (347-406 AD).
- (c) Three **problematic Theologians**
 - (i) Appolinarius, bishop of Laodicea (392 AD)
 - (ii) Eutyches of Constantinople
 - (iii) Nestorius, bishop of Constantinople.

MBS 510: Discuss the first, second and third centuries persecutions against Christians AND Highlight the persecution of the following emperors:

- (a) The Tyranny of Nero (reigned 54-68AD).
- (b) The Tyranny of Domitian (reigned 81-95AD).
- (c) The Tyranny of Trajan in the second Century (98-117AD)
- (d) Decius- 248-253 AD.
- (e) Valerian's Persecution Leadership Style in 277AD.

MBS 520: Research the major themes in the epistle of James. The student must use Biblical language to explain the following:

- The Tongue (3:1–12)
- The Wisdom from Above (3:13–18)
- Friendship with the World (4:1–10)
- Judging a Brother (4:11–12)
- Warning against Boasting (4:13–17)
- Warning to the Rich (5:1–6)
- Patience and Prayer (5:7–20)
