Purpose

This exciting program is designed to expose the student to the overall training that is suitable to Ministry preparation. The candidate must have a high-degree interest in either urban or rural ministry. The program will educate the student about the role of the pastor using the Chief apostle as a springboard upon which he will build his ministry. The student will learn the role of the shepherd in Psalm 23, and the general function of the shepherd in the Christian Church. The program will educate the student in the area of pastoral leadership, philosophy, Ethics, Church History, the Doctrine of God and humankind, Evangelism, Pastoral studies, and Biblical Preaching.

Program Requirements

COURSES.

MIN 400. Deliberate on the impact of **First Century** persecution on Christianity. Accentuate the role of Emperors Claudius (41-54 AD), Nero (54-68 AD), and Domitian (81-95 AD).

MIN 440. Discuss inerrancy of scripture and base your discussion on the meaning of inerrancy, language of the Bible, grammatical constructions of the Bible and challenges of inerrancy.

MIN. 460. Discuss the **four major characteristics** of scripture.

MIN 420. **Explicate four** characteristics of sufficiency of scripture.

MIN 510. Elucidate Biblical and Theological Foundation of **pastoral care and** seriously consider the following:

- a) Pastor as the shepherd (1 Peter 1-11)
- b) Pastor as the watchman (Heb. 13:15-17)
- c) Pastor as overseer (Acts 20: 17-35)
- d) Pastor as the spring of joy for the Church (Phil.4:1-11) **(5 units)**

MIN 530. Discuss the concept of a good shepherd in Psalm 23, and use scriptures in both the Old and the New Testaments to enumerate the role of the shepherd in the twenty-first Century Church. Consider the role of false shepherds of Israel in Ezekiel 34. Relate good and false shepherds to your ministry **(5 units)**.

MIN 540. Use Louis Berkhoff, Wayne Grudem, Erickson, Norman Geisler and other renowned systematic Theological books, journals, and articles to discuss the **intellectual, communicable, moral, and sovereign Attributes** of God. Relate these attributes to your ministry **(5 units)**.

MIN. 550. Define the term **anthropomorphism** and biblically demonstrate the use of the term in both the Old and New Testaments. Use renowned or published books, journals and articles to discuss your course work. Relate the attributes of anthropomorphism to your ministry **(5 units)**.

MIN 560. Explain the difference between **dichotomy and trichotomy** of the human person. Support your answer using the Bible and renowned published books, articles, and journals **(5 units)**.

MIN 570: Missions and the sovereignty of God are made manifest in Paul's Missionary endeavors in Athens (Acts 17: 16-31). Enumerate the achievements, blessings and difficulties of Paul's ministry in the City. Lay Emphasis on religion **and culture (Acts 17:22-23), Basis of hope in Evangelism (Acts 17:23), the greatness of God (Acts 17:24-25), the uniqueness of God's people (Verses 26-28), calling idol worshippers to turn to God (verse 29), and repentance (verses 30-31) (5 units)**.

MIN 580: Research the controversies surrounding **circumcision** and elaborate on both the Old and New Testaments types of circumcision. What are Paul's arguments about circumcision in his letter to the Galatians and other Churches? Relate the doctrine of circumcision to your ministry **(5 units)**.

MIN 590: Since the beginning of creation, **sex, money, and power** have contributed enormously to the advancement of humanity, **BUT** the **three** are considered the axis of **evil** of human endeavors. Expatiate on the repercussions of the **abuse of sex, power, and money** relate the use of **money, sex, and power** to your ministry **(5 units)**.

MIN 600: Describe the importance and significance of Christology in Christian belief, Christian doctrine, and Christology in the **New and Old Testaments (5 units)**.

MIN 610: The Pharisees, the Sadducees, the zealots, the Essenes, and teachers of the law vehemently opposed Jesus' Ministry. Describe the doctrine of the sects and explain the method you will use to avert the assaults and harassments of such powerful social structures in the 21st Century Church **(5 units)**.

MIN 620: Research biblical commands on Christian marriage and accentuate Jesus' teaching on marriage. Relate the doctrine of marriage to your ministry **(5 units)**.

MIN 630: Fasting and Prayer play a pivotal role in the advancement of Christianity and the ministries of the apostles in the **bible**. Discuss the positive impact of fasting and prayer in the New Testament on your ministry **(5 units)**.

MIN 640: Research lexical items used in both the Old and New Testaments to describe the **Church**. Place emphasis on the New Testament's Church and its positive impact on your Ministry **(5 units)**.

MIN 650: Research worship in the Reformation and charismatic Churches and emphasize Contemporary worship, Erasmus of Rotterdam, sacramental controversy, Luther, Calvin, Zwingli, the use of the word, and the psalm **(5 units)**.

MIN 660: Discuss the importance of Angels in Christian ministry. Refer to the role of Angels in both the Old and New Testaments. Student must mention the relationship between angels and Jesus' birth and ministry, the creation of angels, the immortality of angels, and the organization of Angels.

MIN 670: Research the major themes in the epistle of James and explain the following. The student must include references and bibliography.

- The Tongue (3:1–12)
- The Wisdom from Above (3:13–18)
- Friendship with the World (4:1–10)
- Judging a Brother (4:11–12)
- Warning against Boasting (4:13–17)
- Warning to the Rich (5:1–6)
- Patience and Prayer (5:7–20)

MBS 680: Discuss the development of Ante-Nicene Theology and highlight the following in your discussion:

- (a) Clement of Alexandria (c-150-215 AD)
- (b) Origen (c 184-254 AD)

(c) (Cyprian (c 200-258)

The conversion of Constantine (274/280-337).

MBS 690: Research the LIVES and accomplishments of the following **famous Church fathers**:

(A) Ambrose 340-397 AD.

(B) John Chrysostom (347-406 AD).

(C) Three **problematic Theologians**

(I) Appolinarius, bishop of Laodicea (392 AD)

(II) Eutyches of Constantinople

(III) Nestorius, bishop of Constantinople.

MBS 700: Discuss the first, second and third centuries persecutions against Christians

AND Highlight the persecution of the following emperors:

(a) The Tyranny of Nero (reigned 54-68AD).

(b) The Tyranny of Domitian (reigned 81-95AD).

(c) The Tyranny of Trajan in the second Century (98-117AD)

(d) Decius- 248-253 AD.

(e) Valerian's Persecution Leadership Style in 277AD.
