## POLICY OF DEGREE PROGRAMS OFFERED

WINNING LIFE THEOLOGICAL SEMINARY (WINNING LIFE PRAYER MINISTRY) COMES UNDER SECTION 94874 OF BUREAU FOR PRIVATE POSTSECONDARY EDUCATION OF CALIFORNIA, DEPARTMENT OF CONSUMER AFFAIRS (CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION).

**Section (e) 1.** Winning Life Theological Seminary (Winning Life Prayer Ministry) is an institution owned, controlled, and operated and maintained by a religious Organization lawfully operating as a nonprofit religious corporation pursuant to Part 4 (commencing with section 9110 of Division 2 of Title 1 of the Corporations Code, that meets all of the following requirements:

- (A) Winning Life Theological Seminary (Winning Life Prayer Ministry) is limited to the principles of The Seminary's Courses offered pursuant to section 2789 of Business and Professions Code.
- (B) The Diploma or degree is limited to evidence of completing a degree program at Winning Life Theological Seminary.
- (2) Winning Life Theological Seminary (Winning Life Prayer Ministry) offers degrees and diplomas only in the beliefs and practices of the SEMINARY, which includes (Christianity, all protestant denominations, all Pentecostal or evangelical denominations, all Charismatic denominations in America and abroad). Members of these organizations as well as all other denominations are qualified to apply for enrollment. Catholics, Buddhists, Hindu faithful are welcome to apply for enrollment.
- (3) Winning Life Theological Seminary (Winning Life Prayer Ministry) does not award degrees in any area of physical science.
- (4) Any degree or diploma that Winning Life Theological Seminary (Winning Life Prayer Ministry) grants to candidates, shall contains on its face, in the written description of the title of the degree being conferred, a reference to the Seminary's aspect of the degree's subject area.
- (5) A degree awarded under this subdivision shall reflect the nature of the degree title, such as "Associate Degree of Biblical Studies", "Bachelor of Theology", "Master of Divinity", "Doctor of Ministry", and "Doctor of Philosophy in Biblical Studies."
