Snow Removal

During these winter months we kindly ask that homeowners try to utilize their garages whenever possible and to be considerate when moving vehicles to allow for timely snow removal. Snow removal commences when snow accumulations are equal to or greater than two inches. In addition, homeowners are encouraged to utilize calcium chloride (ice-melt) to sidewalks to assist with safety. **Do Not** use rock salt as it will damage the concrete surfaces and do not shovel snow into roadways. In addition, we thank you all for your patience during the snowstorm last year. We are aware that the process did not meet the expectations of many and therefore, CYC and the Board are working to improve the process.

Holiday Decorations

Homeowners can display holiday decorations; however, all decorations must be considered appropriate for the community and removed in conjunction to the associated holiday.

Application for Exterior Change

An **Application for Exterior Change** must be submitted and approved for all changes to the exterior of your home. Examples of these changes are included below:

- Landscaping
- Light Fixtures
- o Antenna
- Doors
- Vents

- Awnings
- Windows
- Gutters
- Deck
