Dear President Trump,

Firstly, I would like to wish you a happy Independence Day and congratulate you on your success in negotiations with North Korea. A feat many before you failed to peacefully resolve, and one that will no doubt bring a lasting peace to the Korean peninsula.

I am writing you today to petition for your support to finally bring an end to the illegal occupation and usurpation of Wales and Cornwall, by the United Kingdom. This act of support would end the largest and longest running case of fraud the world has ever seen; as the English have presented themselves as Britons or British, yet a simple examination of their own history or the recent DNA findings by Oxford University will reveal that they are not Britons. They are in fact the descendants of the Anglo-Saxons and Normans, and the Welsh and the Cornish are the true Britons.

The ancestors of the English did not arrive on the island of Britain until 550 A.D., after the end of the Roman occupation, and yet they have presented themselves to the international family of nations as the senior people of the island. The United Kingdom misled the United Nations in September of 2007 when they stated there was not an ethnic group that would fall "*within the scope of the indigenous peoples to which the Declaration applied*". The DNA evidence shows the United Nations Declaration on the Rights of Indigenous Peoples clearly applies to the Britons.

The usurpation of Wales and Cornwall has long been disputed via diplomatic protest in accordance with the public international law, and as such the Britons have preserved their sovereignty just as the Hebrews preserved theirs in their time of

exile from Israel. Wales and Cornwall have flown their own flags, and have maintained their own borders, customs, traditions, and languages despite the English attempting to assimilate them.

The English currently use Wales and Cornwall as resource pools and retirement havens. Against the democratic voice of the Britons they have stolen resources and have flooded a Welsh village to create a water reservoir for England. They have historically beaten our children in school for speaking the native language of the island. They have attempted to rewrite history in their favour.

In accordance with our native Welsh laws and customs and in the pursuit of bringing an end to these many great injustices, in keeping with the law of nations I have assumed the position of leadership of the Britons and claimed the title Rex Britannorum or King of Britons; which is the historical title of the leader of the Britons. This act has not been performed for centuries out of fear, as one of the previous leaders of the Britons, Llywelyn ap Gruffudd had his head removed and placed on a spike for over a decade in London. Since taking on this task I have gained followers in Cornwall, Wales, the United States of America, and around the world who are like minded and wish to see justice finally done for the Britons.

Although the public international law and jurists have honoured my inheritance of sovereign titles and lawful claim to the headship of the nation of Britons; as you are aware according to the United States Constitution and the Supreme Courts findings in *Banco Nacional de Cuba v. The power of the executive to make the determination of sovereignty has long been honoured as a political decision, and not a legal decision or determination. My recognition in the United States, although a lawful one, is currently only informal.


Sixteen of the signatories on the original draft of the Declaration of Independence were of Briton (Welsh) descent. They were the largest ethnic group

It is my great hope that you will not only take up the noble path and recognize and honour the sovereignty of the Britons living in Wales and Cornwall, whom worked generation after generation to preserve it; but that also you will assist us in mediations with the United Kingdom, as the public international law states that we are entitled to reparations for the fraud that has occurred within the preamble of the Laws in Wales Act. There was no lawful union between Wales and England prior to the Laws in Wales Act and Wales has diplomatically protested the usurpation of the nation since then, making the Laws in Wales Act null and void.

Again, I congratulate you on your unparalleled works as the President of the United States of America, and I commend you on the leadership that you have bravely proven and provided.
