> CROHN'S DISEASE 101 A BASIC GUIDE



Crohn's disease is a chronic inflammatory bowel disease (IBD) characterized by inflammation of the gastrointestinal (GI) tract.

- It can affect any part of the GI tract, from the mouth to the anus
- It is not caused by food
 There is no cure
- It is not contagious

SYMPTOMS INCLUDE:

Frequent recurring diarrhea, rectal bleeding, unexplained weight loss, fever, abdominal pain and cramping, fatigue and a feeling of low energy, reduced appetite.

Other facts about symptoms:

- · Inflammation plays a role in your symptoms
- · Symptoms range from mild to severe



CROHN'S IS

- Varies between periods when disease is active, or flaring, and when it is in remission (few or no symptoms)
- Varies from person to person and may change over time
 When Crohn's is flaring, symptoms may make it
- difficult to keep to a usual routine

The exact cause is unknown

CROHN'S TREATMENT



- Because Crohn's is chronic, ongoing treatment is required
- There are many different kinds of medications available
- People with Crohn's should work with their doctor to create a treatment plan and set treatment goals



INSURANCE CHEATSHEET



Premium Monthly payment. Health premiums went up by 4% in 2020.



Out-of-Pocket Maximum Max paid in a plan year, after deductibles, copayments and coinsurance. Plan pays the rest.



Deductible Amount you have to pay before your insurance kicks in for expenses.



In-Network vs. Out-of Network

In-Network makes your costs cheaper, always check if references are in-network .



Coinsurance / Copayment

% you have to pay after deductible is met. Copayment is a fixed amount you pay out-ofpocket for visits.



Nationwide Coverage If you plan to move,

consider nationwide coverage.


