Purpose

Whole Foundation conducts ethically guided research and quality improvement to advance care for foster and adoptive children. Some research is funded by grants from private foundations, state or national organizations. Research may be published for the benefit of all foster and adoptive children, their carers and to advance policy at the local, state and federal levels.

Types of Data That May Be Used

- Assessment scores without identifiers
- Program participation and outcomes
- Symptom or functional trends over time
- Aggregated demographic information
- Caregiver-reported measures

Privacy & Ethical Safeguards

All data will be stripped of direct identifiers and reported only in aggregate or anonymized form. No identifiable medical records will be shared.

Voluntary Participation

Participation is voluntary and may be withdrawn at any time without affecting access to services.
