Our lake is the greatest asset we have in Venetian Estates, we all need to make sure that we are good stewards of this precious resource for future generations to enjoy. Our property values are tied directly to this lake, as goes Lake Venetian goes the neighborhood. The Board has recently voted to move from a lake maintenance program to a lake management program. This lake management

approach will involve additional testing of the water, both in Lake Venetian and one of our main sources, Lake Eldridge. We want to make sure that the water quality of Lake Venetian is maintained so we all can continue to enjoy the recreational aspects of our lake. Each summer I see more and more activity in Venetian Lake, if you have seen some of the Halloween Hayride pictures you can see why. There were close to 90 chil-

dren that participated in this event. Another part of this management program will be to set up an aeration system throughout the lake. We have identified about 10 houses where a small generator can possibly be located to feed the aeration hoses throughout the lake. A board member will be contacting those homes in the coming weeks to see if you can assist the neighborhood with this project. This all will be followed up by adding vegetation and more fish to enhance the beauty and health of our lake. The Board is also looking at ways to remove the silt in our lake that has been building up since the beginning of Venetian Estates. There is no easy solution to this removal process, so we are taking our time to listen to ideas and proposals that are most cost effective and less intrusive to our daily lake life. So, stay tuned, good things to come soon to enhance our lake life on Lake Venetian!!! Carol & I would like to wish everyone a Happy and Safe Holiday Season. We look forward to seeing you all at the Christmas party and at our annual meeting in January.












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## **National Night Out**

We recognize that the lake is our most cherished asset in the neighborhood. Our lake is unique in a few ways. The lake does not have an incoming and outgoing water source, it is 100% bulkheaded, and it serves as the neighborhood storm drain. These issues lead to several difficult problems to address. For this reason, we are in the process of forming a partnership with a lake management company that specializes in addressing urban lake issues. The problems we face cannot be addressed overnight, and we hope to share some specifics with you during the upcoming annual meeting.
