Lake Report Spring 2025

It's early in the year, but so far, we have not had to pump replenishment water from Lake Eldridge due to timely rains. Along with the rain, storm water comes from our streets and yards and ends up in the lake. It is particularly important to keep your street gutters clean at this time of year from all the fallen leaves. Otherwise, the leaves end up in our lake and add to our sediment base. As the temperature begins to increase for the final time, we will restart our fish feeding program in March. As a reminder, please use your running lights (no headlights or spotlights) when boating at night and stay towards the middle of the waterways to respect residents' privacy.

We dye the lake every two months or more frequently as needed.



Block Captains

Block Captains are an integral part of Venetian Estates. They plan many street parties throughout the year and are usually the first point of contact for new residents. Make sure to thank your Block Captain and ask them how you can assist them for the next block party/event.

Block Captains are also responsible for the distribution of yard flags before certain events and special dates. The next two dates for yard flags are May 26-- Memorial Day and Memorial Car Parade, and July 4th-- Independence Day and the Boat Parade.
