### FLY Dress Code:

- FabPole Silks:** Shorts, cap/short sleeve shirt, tank top. Also, for comfort while getting used to fabric: long sleeve shirt or something to cover arms, leg warmers or pants.
- Pole:** Shorts; tank top. Extra short sleeves shirt or warm up shirt optional and leggings or pants are optional.
- Aerial Hoop:** Sturdy leggings, snug fitting long sleeve top. The hoops are heavy and wrapped in tape for grip. The grip can grab clothing so easily snagged clothing should not be worn. Long sleeves are recommended but not required.
- Aerial Hammock:** Leggings or capris, cap/short sleeve shirt.

### FLY Studio Policies:

- Fees may be paid in 3 equal instalments per session with a credit card on file.
- If a session has less than 3 students enrolled two weeks before the start date, the session may be cancelled.
- There will be no refunds for missed classes. Make-up classes will only be offered if a class is cancelled by the studio.
- There will be no refunds for classes cancelled by the studio due to severe weather conditions.
- Parents are responsible for contacting the studio via call/text/email if their child will be absent from class.
- If cancelling a 12 week session at any time throughout the 12 weeks, a \$50.00 cancellation fee must be paid (or the balance of the session, whichever is less).
- Warm up starts promptly at the class start time. Please do not arrive late as this disrupts the class in progress: if your child is late they must enter the studio quietly and wait for the instructor to welcome them to class.
- Students should be picked up within 10 minutes after class ends.
- All students must follow the dress code. Students must show respect to teachers and peers at all times. Negative behaviour will not be tolerated as all FLY programs are intended to be a positive learning experience. If a student is not adhering to these requirements, parents will be notified. If issues are not corrected a student may not be allowed to continue. There will be no refunds for these circumstances.
- Children who are not participating in classes may not be left unsupervised at the studio.
- Parents and friends are not permitted in studios during classes except on demo days.
- There is no gum, food or drink allowed in the studios with the exception of student water bottles.
- Fly is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
- No jewelry allowed in class.
- Parents of any students caught vandalizing studio property will be responsible for damages.
- It is the responsibility of the parent to make sure they are receiving all emails and information given out to students at the studio. Please check the website regularly as well as reply to our initial confirmation email to ensure you are receiving all information.
- Absolutely no outdoor footwear is permitted past the entrance landing.
