Wait-list Policy: BDTA is offering a waitlist to fill openings created by withdrawn entries prior to closing. A maximum of 25 entries will be placed on the club's waitlist. All entries, including wait-listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to the trial closing date listed on the premium. Any entries withdrawn will be replaced by a wait-listed entry, if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait-listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.

- 4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed.
