**Telegraph, Telephone, hand carried and Unsigned entries Cannot be Accepted.**

Entries not on official AKC Entry forms or photocopies of entry forms **without the agreement and rules of the official AKC entry form are NOT ACCEPTABLE.**

**Acknowledgement of entries:** Email confirmation of receipt of entry will be made as soon as possible as entries are received and processed, **if a legible email address is provided.** Final confirmation, numbers and judging schedule will be sent via email after Trial closes and processing is complete. Please check your spam mailbox also. Should acknowledgement not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time, please notify the Obedience/Rally Trial Secretary, Linda Arnold, 102 Coverdale Road, Butler, PA 16001 (lindy53@zoominternet.net)

**No Refund for Duplicate Entries.** Every effort will be made to find duplicate entries; however, if the entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

**Wait-list Policy:** BDTA is offering a waitlist to fill openings created by withdrawn entries prior to closing. A maximum of 25 entries will be placed on the club's waitlist. All entries, including wait-listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to the trial closing date listed on the premium. Any entries withdrawn will be replaced by a wait-listed entry, if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait-listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait-listed entry that does not move off the waitlist into the trial by 11:00 PM, September 17, 2025, will be refunded.

**Declination of Entries. No Entry** shall be made, and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Butler Dog Training Association may decline any entries and may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness, or other cause, and no one shall have any claim against BDTA or any official thereof.

**Entry Fees Shall Not Be Refunded** in the event a dog is withdrawn after closing, absent, disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by action of the show committee. If because of severe weather, riots, civil disturbances, weather or other acts beyond the control of the BDTA or the Trial Officials it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entries will be made. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance, and, in the event, it is necessary to cancel or stop a trial before completion, no refund of entry fees will be made.

**Errors On Entry Blanks.** Owners are responsible for errors in the filing out of entry forms. No entry and no entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors, or for cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Please type or **print carefully** on entry forms to eliminate errors.

**Transfers/Move-up Policy.** Obedience and Rally Transfers to another class will be accepted as space permits within entry limits, in accordance with Chapter 1, Section 16 of the Obedience Regulations. Requests for transfers must be made in writing and presented to trial secretary at least **30 minutes before the start of each Trial.** Forms may be downloaded from the AKC website at [www.akc.org](http://www.akc.org) or requested from the Trial Secretary.

**Bitches in Season** will not be admitted to the Trial. Any exhibitor with an entered bitch in season on the Trial date will be refunded the entry fee **less \$5.00** upon written certification by a veterinarian given to the Trial Secretary **before the start of judging each trial.**

**Exhibitors are Responsible for the Behavior of Their Dogs and/or Children.** All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crates outside except when being judged or when in the exercising area. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any entry fees will be made.

**Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class.** Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.

\*Due to space limitations, please plan to crate in your car. Crating spaces will only be offered to BDTA Workers/Committee Members with dogs and Officials of the Trial.

Exhibitors may enter the building prior to their class(s) to acclimate your dog(s). Some seating will be available; however, this may change as BDTA will follow CDC, PA and county guidelines in effect at the time of the trial.
