Payment Schedule is as follows:

If dues are received by June 15th, there will be the following discount:

Full, Senior, Associate Membership.....\$45 Lifetime.....\$0

Jr. Membership.....\$30

Family Discount....\$45 for 1st member, \$40 for each additional member

If dues are received between June 16th-July 15th, full payment is due:

Full, Senior, Associate Membership.....\$55 Lifetime\$0

Jr. Membership.....\$35

Family Discount....\$55 for 1st member, \$45 for each additional member

If dues are received between July 16th -August 15th, there will be a late fee:

Full, Senior, Associate Membership.....\$65 Lifetime.....\$0

Jr. Membership.....\$40

Family Discount....\$65 for 1st member, \$50 for each additional member

After August 15th, you will be asked to re-apply for membership.

Please note that payment must be received by the above dates, not postmarked!!!!!!

With full membership in BDTA comes individual responsibility for each member. The following are the expectations that must be met by members during the coming year beginning June 15, 2026. Members must volunteer eight hours of their time during the year. If these requirements are not met by June 15, 2027, your membership will revert to an Associate Membership for the following year.

1. Instruct and/or assisting a class.
2. Serve on a committee.
3. Serve as an Officer or on the Board
4. Help with a CGC/TDI Test
5. Help with events such as: BDTA Trials, Workshops, Seminars, Clean-up days and presentations (presentations can be Dog Safety Demos, Canine Ambassador events, meet n' greets, therapy visits, etc...)

Below are the levels of membership. **Read them carefully.** Please circle the membership level you are renewing for on the renewal form. Some of you may qualify for more than one level. Please choose the one that best suits your needs for the coming year.

Full membership shall be open to all persons who are eighteen years of age and older, are in good standing with the American Kennel Club, and who subscribe to the purpose of this Association. Dues are required. Full members are **required to fulfill membership requirements**. Full members shall enjoy all the privileges of the Association. Full members privileges include voting, half price classes, being able to hold office, reservation of the building and Member classes. If requirements as defined in Section 3 are not met, Full membership reverts to an Associate Membership for the following year.

Junior membership shall be open to all persons who are ten to seventeen years of age, are in good standing with the American Kennel Club, and subscribe to the purpose of this Association. Dues are required, Junior members are **required to fulfill membership requirements**. Junior members shall enjoy limited privileges. Junior member privileges include half price classes and Member classes. Junior members are not able to vote or hold office.

Senior membership shall be open to all persons who are seventy years of age and older, are in good standing with the American Kennel Club, and subscribe to the purpose of this Association. Dues are required. Senior members are **NOT required to fulfill membership requirements**. Senior members shall enjoy all the privileges of the Association. Senior members privileges include Voting, half price classes, being able to hold office, reservation of the building and Member classes.

Lifetime membership shall be open to all persons who have maintained Club membership for twenty-five consecutive years or more, are in good standing with the American Kennel Club, and subscribe to the purpose of this Association. Dues are NOT required. **Lifetime members are required to fulfill membership requirements.** Lifetime members shall enjoy all the privileges of the Association. Lifetime members privileges include Voting, half price classes, able to hold office, reservation of the building and Member classes.

Associate membership shall be open to all persons who are eighteen years of age and older, are in good standing with the American Kennel Club, and subscribe to the purpose of this Association. Dues are required. Associate members are NOT required to fulfill membership requirements. Associate members shall have limited privileges. Associate member privileges include Member classes and attending events. Associate members must pay full price for classes, are not able to vote, hold office or reservation of the building. (May use the building with a member who has building privileges, but must pay \$15 each time.)

You only need to mail in the second page of this document. There will also be copies available at the building. Even if you owe \$0 because you have earned a Lifetime Membership, you still need to mail in a renewal form in order to be kept on the Membership List.
