Wait-list Policy: BDTA is offering a waitlist to fill openings created by withdrawn entries prior to closing. A maximum of 25 entries will be placed on the club's waitlist. All entries, including wait-listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to the trial closing date listed on the premium.
