


JACOB

Terah – Abraham’s Father





“And Abraham said of Sarah his wife, She is my sister...” Genesis 20:2


“And yet indeed she is my sister; she is the daughter of my father, but not the daughter of my mother; and she became my wife.” Genesis 20:12





The sons of Jacob's second family wanted to kill Joseph. Instead, they put him in a pit and he was sold into slavery.


Is a man's salvation with his second or third wife?

Narrow Gate




In this scenario, the child carries the family forward and the mother is the vine.

Wide Gate

*“But I say unto you, That whosoever shall put away his wife, saving for the cause of fornication, causeth her to commit adultery: and whosoever shall marry her that is divorced committeth adultery. (Matthew 5:32)

*“And I say unto you, Whosoever shall put away his wife, except it be for fornication, and shall marry another, committeth adultery: and whosoever marrieth her which is put away doth commit adultery. (Matthew 19:9)

*The Pharisees asked Jesus, Is it lawful for a man to put away his wife? tempting him. Jesus asked them, “What did Moses command you?” They said, Moses suffered to of your heart he wrote you this precept. But from the beginning of the creation God made them male and female. For this cause shall a man leave his father and mother, and cleave to his wife; And they twain shall be one flesh: so then they are no more twain, but one flesh. What therefore God hath joined together, let not man put asunder. Whosoever shall put away his wife, and marry another, committwrite a bill of divorcement, and to put her away. Jesus answered them, “For the hardness eth adultery against her. And if a woman shall put away her husband, and be married to another, she committeth adultery.” (Mark 10:2-12)

*“Whosoever putteth away his wife, and marrieth another, committeth adultery; and whosoever marrieth her that is put away from her husband commeth adultery.” (Luke 16:18)

*Jacob said that Leah’s sons made him stink!



JUDAH TRICKED US

The family system that he established was so confusing that Judah most likely had to kill every child from his first family. In Genesis it says that his sons from his first family were evil and the Lord killed them. But I do not believe that God killed them. A man killed them – a powerful man that was referred to as “Lord”. These sons refused to lay with their deceased brother’s wife in the way that Judah expected. In order to get this system going, fathers had to have absolute power over their children. This would be a requirement so that he could have the freedom to go to and move in with another woman. The man had to be like God. (Genesis 38:7-10)

Judah’s sons obviously were not comfortable with laying with just any woman. Today, our men go from woman to woman and stay with the last woman that they lay with.

DO NOT FOLLOW DOERS OF INIQUITY

The problem is the “remarriage” and leaving to move in with someone else. The man or woman must leave the first one and move in with the second and start over. In many cases, children will never see their parent again and if they do, it will be in their parent’s home with the other man or woman.


Sons of God
