New Members

- All new members are under a 6 months' probationary period & can have their membership terminated during this time if deemed necessary.
- Membership cards should be carried always and shown to a Board member or staff member if requested.
- Members can sign a guest in but are responsible for this person throughout their visit & must pay a visitor's fee. Non-members can visit the club 3 times in a calendar year and then must become members if they wish to visit again (this includes any family member aged 18 or over).
- Members with children are reminded that they are responsible for the conduct of their children when in the club and its surrounds & must ensure they do not run around inside.
- Smoking of any type of cigarette (including E-Cigarettes) is not permitted within the building.

The following general points are not considered acceptable by the Board of Management, staff or club members and could lead to suspension of membership and ultimate expulsion. Please note that our club is a member of Desborough Club Watch (The Old Works, The Football Club & The Conservative Club) – so if you are barred from one of the clubs you will be barred from all of them.

1. Rowdiness or fighting
2. Persistent loud and abusive or offensive language
3. Abuse of any kind towards staff and members
4. The usage or selling of any illegal substances anywhere within the club premises or grounds
5. The Purchase of any alcohol for any under-age drinkers or the drinking of any alcohol not purchased from the club bar
6. Damage to club property or theft.
