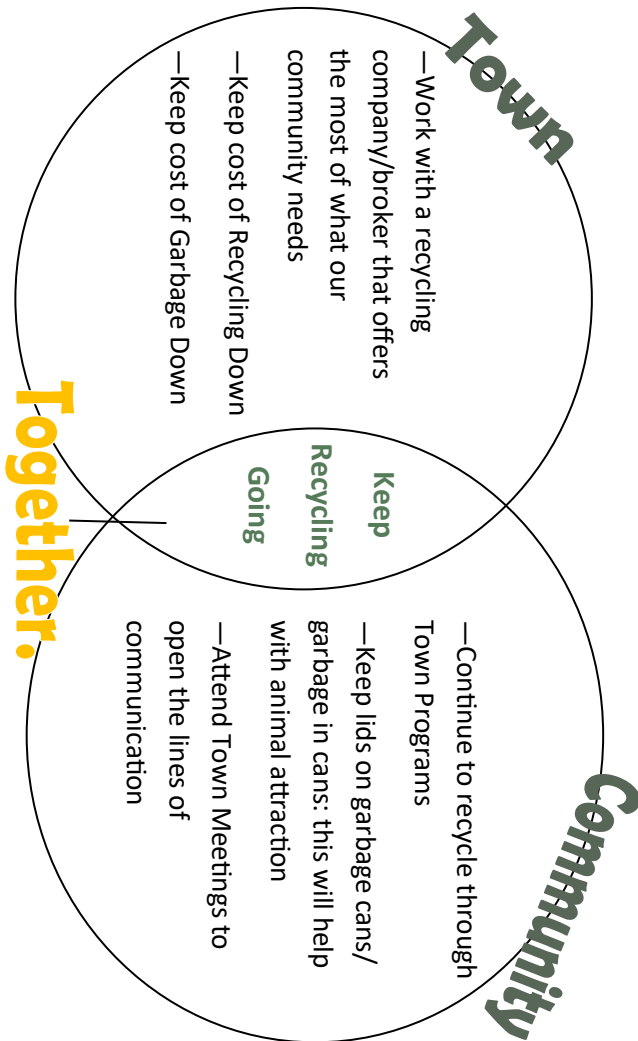

Trailer Material Fee: \$0.00—they would have paid us, however this covers the transportation cost	Material in Trailer Fee: \$40.00/ton X 20ton= \$800.00 we pay

# Clearing the Air...

Town of Lusk utility holders that pay for garbage pickup are:

1. Responsible for purchasing their own garbage cans *with lids*
2. May not use garbage cans *bigger than 30 pounds*
3. May have as many garbage cans as they choose

Because of the lightness of plastics, it is not projected that taking them to the transfer station will have a bearing on any rate increases.

We will still continue to offer our same recycling programs that we have before.

As previously explored, it is not cost productive to :

- Bring in TDS dumpsters
- Transport recycling to another town
- Store/Ship plastics once we have reached the required tonnage. \*We also do not have the room for this.

## A New Partnership-

The Town of Lusk, in an effort to keep as much recycling going as possible, has entered into a new partner ship with Centennial Recycling, a broker .

Unfortunately, because of the current lack of demand on recyclables, our program will look much different then it has in the past and we will no longer be able to accept certain items.

## Different Avenues

The Town of Lusk has considered several different avenues to be able to still offer recycling. We understand how important recycling is, how it helps to improve our environment and animal safety, and what it means to our community members. The one we are currently implementing was the best choice we could make.

## What this means for you-

- At this time, extra plastics in the garbage are not projected to cause an increase in garbage rates. Plastics simply do not weigh enough to cause much of a change.
- At this time, the recycling rate is not increasing either.
- Curbside Recycling will still continue
- The recycling center will remain open for community members to dispose of their recyclables.

<b><u>Tubed Electronics carry a fee</u></b> —Computers —T.V.'s Under 25": \$15.00 each 25" & over: \$25.00 each <b>*No Tube=Free</b>	<b>Plastics</b> *You may continue to drop off plastics at the recycling center, however they will not be recycled
<b>Aluminum Cans;</b> Pop Beer Energy drinks, etc.	
<b>Steel/Tin Cans;</b> Canned veggies/fruits Soup cans <b>*make sure they are clean</b>	<b>Paper/Office Pack</b> *You may continue to drop off paper/office pack at the recycling center, however it will not be recycled.
<b>Cardboard</b> Please keep waxy cardboard (pizza boxes, cereal boxes) to a minimum.
