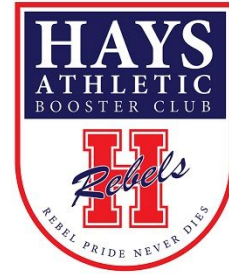


Hays Athletics Booster Club - General Meeting

The HABC meeting was called to order at 6:33 pm.
