credit for being a HABC member. New incentive to sign up by Thursday- entered in to a drawing to win one of three \$80 all sport passes.

Meri is new to coordinating this event. Collecting information/history. Always the last weekend in April unless Easter weekend. BBQ booth fundraiser. Sign up genius closer to event. Student Athletes work booth but need adults too. Bucks under new management. Buda City Park under construction so will update on location for 2020.

- Committee Chair Sponsorships / Fundraising: Rebecca Franchione (interim)
- Rebecca is interim but may become permanent. Voted to double scholarships for this year. Rebecca raised \$10,600. Reports that it was easy to raise as most sponsors had not been asked before. Four different sponsorships. Only three sponsors last year. Digital billboard advertisement on IH35. Have 2-4 banners left to sale this year. Need volunteers to help with putting up and taking down banners. Want to be bigger, better at Hays. Lots of people that want to help. Open for ideas. Work on building the Hays brand. Cane's challenge- Raising Cane's providing 2,000 coupons for football game. Hat Creek providing dinner for varsity football game for Thursday's game. Meri suggested action shots for banners/sponsors. Only limitation is shared stadium so banners have to go up and down for every game. Need volunteer banner coordinator. Senior banners will also be hung for each game. Sponsor banners are to be hung on far/visitor side. Banners cannot block handicap view. Can publicize sponsors on HABC social media. HISD Central Athletic Coordinator position may be filled soon and rules for the stadium may change.

- Introduction of Coaches & Updates from Coaches Coach Matt Sandoval; Boys Basketball. 4 years at HAYS. Teaches Math. Ready to go. Coach Danny Preuss; 30<sup>th</sup> year. Basketball, Golf. Teaches History.
- Financial Updates see attached report by Holly Raymond. Total assets \$53,369.43 after scholarship pay out. Healthy bank account. Financial year starts Aug. 1 but this report includes July. Concessions have already made \$1,000. Scholarships are up. Baseball pass through fundraiser- baseball player's dad passed away and family chose to give donations to the baseball team through the booster club. Paid out the \$3,000 for Red & Blue. Intentional drawn down explanation. Goal is to give back to the kids not sitting on \$\$. How much more can we give back and be comfortable? Voted last meeting to double scholarships. Holly has accounting background to assist with financial decisions.

- o Currently @ 112 members. (At this time last year we had: 78 members.) Keep inviting and encouraging participation!
- Bleacher Creatures Marla Rice will be taking on leadership for the BCs. Forms have been distributed and first pass of picking up the forms has been done (today, 8/26). A 2nd pass for form pick-up will happen on Monday, 9/16. Shirts have been ordered.
- 71 signed up so far. Anticipate 175 total sign ups. Need volunteers to help coordinate elementary children.

Students can volunteer for NJHS hours. Short window since school began this year and first game to collect forms so will pass out t-shirts at first game/first drop off night. Need double the volunteers for the first night. Marla making name badges for volunteers for identification as volunteers. 30-45 minutes first game. Also, senior parent night.

- Parking Passes (126 sold of 160 as of 8/24; at this time last year 75 of 150 sold.)

  Approx. 30 passes left to be sold. Have some veteran parking volunteers but need additional volunteers to help out.. \$10 for parking slots. Need help with taking money and parent drops. Need volunteer help 5-7:45 p.m.

- We have raised **\$10,600** in **sponsorships** in four different packages: Game Day (\$1000), Banner (\$500), Bleacher Creatures (\$500), and Individual/Family/Booster (\$100).
