The maternal sample	10ml maternal blood
The alleged father's samples	<ul> <li>2-5ml of alleged father venous blood</li> <li>Buccal swab</li> <li>5-10 hairs with hair follicles</li> <li>5-10 fingernails</li> <li>Bloodstain</li> </ul>

## If your baby has already been born:

Types of Sample	Requirements
Bloodstain	> 1cm in diameter
Hair with Follicle	1-3 hair with follicle
Fingernail	3-5 pieces of fingernail clippings
Buccal swab	To swab the inside of his/her cheek for 15 seconds
